

TEXAS UIL RECLASSIFICATIONS AND REALIGNMENT FOR 2020-2021 and 2021--2022

The announcement that every high school athlete and coach was waiting for was released at 9am today, Monday, February 1, 2018. Every two years the Texas UIL makes changes in the classification of Texas high schools for major sports based on attendance. In addition, they realign the schools into Regions and Districts based on location and other schools in the area. This year there were 1500 schools in Texas involved. All of the changes below begin in the next school year and are effective for two years.

Georgetown High and Georgetown East View will remain in Class 5A for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years. Both of these schools have been moved from Region 3, District 19 into Region 3 District 18. Below are the schools that will be competing with Georgetown and East View in district play.
