The Georgetown-Williams County Veterans Memorial Advisory Group installs memorial bricks at the Veterans Memorial Plaza three times a year, in mid-May, mid-August and mid-December. Order submission cutoff dates are 30 April, 31 July and 20 November.

Sponsors, donors, or purchasers will be notified by email when the Veterans Memorial Advisory Group (VMAG) has received the order. They will be given the estimated date their brick will be ordered and installed. Upon receipt of a final delivery date from the brick vendor, the sponsors, donors, or purchasers will be notified again of the date and time of installation and instructions on how to locate their brick once it has been installed.

There is no ceremony involved with the installation of bricks. It is strictly a construction type project with the removal of blank bricks and the installing of the engraved bricks. However, those who have purchased a brick may attend to witness the placement of the bricks and are encouraged to take photos if they so desire.

Please be aware that this brick order form must be filled out completely. It is imperative that each brick line only contain sixteen (16) or less characters including spaces. Noncompliance could result in the order being rejected and/or delaying the order and installation. Orders that do not contain an email address may also delay any type of notification.
