Get to Know the Home Ignition Zone (Virtual Workshop)

The three distinct areas surrounding structures within a home ignition zone have been redefined using current research and experience. It also identifies how mitigation and maintenance in each section plays a distinct role in improving survivability during a wildfire. The new home ignition zones are: Zone 1 - 0-5 feet; Zone 2 - 5-30 feet; Zone 3 - 30-100 feet and beyond.
