Firewise Volunteer Clearing Crew News

It has been an extremely slow time for the Clearing Crew this past month. The CA Grounds Crew has been busy clearing areas around our community after the February freeze. Then with all the rain we are in a "holding pattern". But fortunately, as of 4 May, we are able to assist in removing Willow Baccharis and the yard debris in a major drainage ditch in N58 to reduce flooding and debris build up.

Interesting facts to share with you. As of March we were only able to work 4 of the 9 possible Clearing workdays. Of 5 resident requests to review the Level 3 areas behind their homes, the CA and/or the Brightview Contractor had already taken care of 4 of them. (Great jobs guys!)

Remember there are things you can do to help keep debris from becoming fire fuel. Don't put yard debris in the common area.

If you have a concern about the common area behind your home please contact the CA Water, Native Areas, & Landscape Superintendent.
