- Landscape Supervisor:

Carlton said they are working on continuing clearing the creeks and are addressing Level 4 concerns. They have removed 15 trees from creeks and have cleaned up the dam area. He said there are many more trees to be removed. The Level 4 concerns are mostly to address aesthetic concerns rather than Firewise, as neighbors complain about downed trees, etc. Sun City CA has approved of the addition of 3 more workers to his crew. Once the right people are found, having a larger crew will help them work and address needs more quickly.

The EMC hosted a two-day Point of Dispensing (POD) training on January 11 - 12, 2024. Of the attendees about half were from Sun City. A POD is a community location at which state and local agencies distribute medical countermeasures to the public. A POD table top exercise is scheduled for May 2, 2024.
