
Travel Tip Try Ice Cream on your pie. Made with local milk and sweetened with sugar. Then frozen. You'll say, "Mmm Wholesome!"



BOCCELAND: A Sports Paradise

Bocce is the national sport of Bocceland.

When you visit Bocceland expect to see Bocce. Social, friendly, neighborhood, league and advanced combat levels. In the scheme of things you can find players who enjoy Sun City rules and International rules. Other rules may exist but they are only talked about by consenting players. Here's a list of what's happening now. Participants are encouraged and spectators are welcome.



Mixed Leagues:

Mixed Advanced League

Ron Pontiff is the organizer for the advanced tournament.

The top ten ranked players through this year's leagues will automatically advance to the championship tournament on October 23 - 25, starting at 1:00 P.M. Plan to be at the qualification tournament on October 21 - 22, starting at 1:00 P.M. which will decide the remaining 6 to compete in the championship.

Mixed Intermediate League

Grady Jones is the organizer for the intermediate tournament. The top ranked players from this year's leagues will advance into the championship tournament on October 28 - 30.

Women's Championship Tournament:

- 10/10 - Seeding Tournament and Social, 10AM - This will be a one day, three game set to determine the top 10 seeds for the Ladies Championships. The 10 highest scorers will go on to the Tournament. Any ties will be settled by Win/Loss record.
- 10/21-10/22 (if needed), 10AM - Qualifying Tournament for those ladies who did not make the top 10 scorers to advance to the Championships and those others who did/could not make the qualifying rounds. This will be a double elimination tournament with the top six (6) players going on to the 16-person Championship Bracket.
- 10/23-10/25 (if needed), 10AM - Sun City Ladies Championships. This will be a 16-person, double elimination tournament. We will try not to play more than three games a day. Officials will be on each court. They will pick-up and rack balls, determine and post the scores.



Best of Sun City Championship Roll Off:

Top 2 Players from the Advanced, Intermediate and Ladies Leagues will meet in a "Play-Off" for the Bocce Club Traveling Trophy. The event will take place November 1, with a Nov 2 reserved roll off, play off day. Watch for the announcement in the Bocce Club Weekly Reminder so you'll be there to see the best players playing their best. Too bad the USA owns the term SuperBocce. That's what this event is- SuperBocce

BOCCELAND: Building for the future



Capital Improvements Update:

Several capital improvement projects are being considered or are in work:

David Hahn, Director of Facilities was contacted for input and status.

Project 1, Moving the benches on the shed side of the courts, is being evaluated by facilities. Additional hard surface is needed to gain the room to reposition the benches. No decision has been made on the type of surface that will be used. This project is holding up the Bocce Club internal project of expanding the shed.

Projects 2 and 3 are adding lights and adding fans. The Board has not submitted proposals to the Property and Grounds (P&G) Committee for these two Projects. A decision must be made on submitting two single proposals or a combined proposal. The Facilities Department has already submitted their 2020 Budget. This could prevent either of these projects from being completed.

Mr. Hahn did explain that the major issues for completion of these projects are adding additional electrical power (currently there is only one circuit run to the courts) and the ability of the shade structure to support lights and fans. The manufacturer of the structures will need to review the specifications and submit a report.

The goal for submittal of the project proposal(s) to William Blodgett, P&G Chairperson is the end of October.
