UNO BOCCE' NIGHT



BOCCE TIPS Volume 9

New Training Starts: New Comers Training starts on Friday, August 17th, and November 16th, these are three day sessions for new residents, if any members are interested in participating please come join us, it's fun, informative and more importantly enjoyable, I promise.....



Question from Volume 8: Must all balls pass the center line? The pallino must pass across the center line without hitting the back wall in order for it to be a valid throw. If the pallino does not pass over and clear the center line the other team will roll the pallino, and so on until the pallino roll is valid. The team that first attempted to place the pallino will play the first ball.

Bocce ball is valid as soon as it passes over the foul line or lag line (player box line). A ball does not have to pass over the center line to be considered valid and in play. Balls cannot hit the back wall without first striking another ball or pallino.

Good Question: What happens when the pallino leaves the

court? If during play the pallino becomes airborne because it was hit by another ball or tossed over the side or back board. It simply is no longer on the court no matter what. The pallino becomes dead and the frame must be replayed. What happens if a player removes the ball thinking the frame was over? Same rule applies, and the frame needs to be replayed. Moving the pallino is moving the target and it cannot be replaced, under any circumstance.

A Historical Look: In modern times, the first Bocce clubs were organized in Italy. Notably the first Italian League was formed in 1947 by fifteen teams in and around the town of Rivoli (Torino). 1947 also marks the beginning of the yearly Bocce World Championships. This Championship event continues today with participants from over thirty nations – including the United States.

Do you think you'd like to be a leader in the bocce club? Do you imagine all the perks? Do you see yourself making a game-critical call from several courts away? Would you like to be the one to keep the chips, so you could look at them at any time? Want to have to remember the combination of the shed? Would you freeze and forget the combination anytime anyone asked you to open the shed?

Well, our club leaders don't have time for those perks. The leadership job is all about service to the club. Sure, there's the whole administration, money counting, keeping track of all the equipment and tools thing. They might tell you about all the reports and meetings that go along with the job if they ever stopped to discuss it.

But real service to the club shows in the details. Did you ever wonder who paints the lines on the courts, sweeps them clean, washes down the cement areas and chases the raccoons away from the score boards? Oh, you knew the officers did that?!

But did you ever wonder who washes the bocce balls? Yep, the club officers. In late July the current officers, board members and volunteers gave up a Saturday morning to clean where few had cleaned before. On the deck, right in front of everyone, men, and women alike, met to wash and polish the balls.

Watch the snickering, it was all done in the best of taste. All the blue balls were washed together, all the white were given the wash and polish treatment together in equal but separate buckets and the polino cleaning went to the fastest washers. According the Bocce Federation Standards and the Sports Cleaning Regulations, after a ritual washing. each ball was carefully hand polished with a sports sock and even more carefully hand inspected to ensure there were no fingerprints or deviations to measurements.

As an extra inspection step, the now dry balls, were taken to the courts and subjected to high level play by the club leadership and volunteers. The combination of wash weary hands and freshly scrubbed balls produced some wonderful shots and provided a new style of kissing on the courts. Those of us who had learned to play with dirty balls were at a major disadvantage.

And just as suddenly as the games started on the courts, the balls were racked, stored, and locked away. If one were to survey the courts not a soul was in sight. Those who took the trouble to look back to the deck could see the officers, board members and volunteers eating quietly. Service can create quite a hunger.
