

Materials Allowed/Not Allowed

- Wood salvaged from construction sites, metals, PVC, glass (including glass blocks), cement board (Hardiplank® type material), Corian® or similar, marble, Faux Marble or Lucite® are not allowed. If one needs to machine any of these prohibited materials, it must be done out back and the equipment utilized must be thoroughly cleaned before bringing it back inside the woodshop
- Any other material and any used raw material must be shown to the monitor. The monitor has the discretion to prohibit any material from use.
- Exceptions:
 - You may turn acrylics or other plastics on the lathes.
 - Plastic laminates may be cut on the table saws.
 - Members repairing furniture as a club function can work on painted wood.
- Resinous woods (i.e. pine or fir) are not allowed in the wide belt or drum sander.
- Epoxy glue can be used in the wide belt sander. The belts of all other sanders should be cleaned after the use of epoxy. (Only qualified maintainers can clean the drum sander belt.)
- If you have useable boards that you don't want, please put them in the free area.
