NEW ONLINE CLASS REGISTRATION INFORMATION!!!!!

The Computer Club is beginning the process of transferring class registration to an online registration system through the Sun City Computer Club website. A trial involving only 2 classes will begin September 12. The classes involved are Windows 10 scheduled on October 23, 25, & 27 from 9:00 - 11 am, and Windows Files & Folders scheduled on October 26 from Noon – 2:00 pm. If you are interested in registering for either of these classes, you will need to do it through the online calendar found on the Computer Club website, under Training, that can be accessed AFTER LOGGING IN. Full directions as well as how-to videos will be released soon. Those already registered have been transferred to the new system.
