This information is being provided primarily for the benefit of newcomers to the First Time program:

"First Time" is a two-element program designed to assist those Computer Club members who are relatively new at using a computer and would like a better understanding of its use, functions and capabilities.

The first element of the First Time program, called "First Time Presentations," consists of a once-a-month session, lasting no more than 1-1/2 hours, during which time a computer-related topic will be presented followed by a question-and-answer session.

The second element of the First Time program, called "First Time Homeroom," consists of "hands-on" instruction, held several times each month, again lasting no more than 1-1/2 hours. The scheduling of Homeroom sessions are announced via a separate email.

The next First Time "Presentation," whose topic will be "Computer Security," is scheduled to be held next Wednesday, 27 February 2019, from 2:00 until 3:30 p.m. Attendees may want to take notes during this session.

All First Time program gatherings will be held in the Cyber Center Annex room, Activities Center building, 1 Texas Drive.
