^{* &}quot;First Time" is a two-prong program intended to assist those who are relatively new to using a computer and would like to better understand its use, functions and usefulness.

One element of the First Time program, called "First Time - Presentation," consists of a once-a-month session, lasting no more than 1 1/2 hours, during which a computer-related topic will be presented followed by a question-and-answer session.

The next First Time - Presentation will be held on Wednesday, 27 February 2019 from 2:00 until 3:30 p.m. The topic will be "Computer Security."

A second element of the First Time program, called "First Time - Homeroom," consists of "hands-on" sessions, held monthly, and again lasting no more than 1 1/2 hours each. At these sessions, attendees will be encouraged to bring their own computer equipment (desktop, laptop, or tablet) to the event to work one-on-one with an instructor and have their "How Do I . . .?" questions answered.

The next First Time Homeroom session is planned for 22 February 2019, from 1:00 p.m. until 2:30 p.m.
