* "First Time" is a two-prong program intended to assist those who are relatively new to using a computer and would like to better understand its use, functions and usefulness.

One element of the First Time program, called "First Time - Presentations," consists of a once-a-month session, lasting no more than 1-1/2 hours, during which a computer-related topic will be presented followed by a question-and-answer session.

The next First Time - Presentations will be held on Friday, 18 January 2019 from 2:00 until 3:30 p.m. The topic will be "The World Wide Web, a.k.a The Internet."

A second element of the First Time program, called "First Time Homeroom," consists of "hands-on" sessions, held monthly, and again lasting no more than 1 1/2 hours each. At these sessions, attendees will be encouraged to bring their own computer equipment (desktop, laptop, or tablet) to the event to work one-on-one with an instructor and have their "How Do I . . .?" questions answered.

First Time Homeroom sessions also are planned for January 25th., February 8th., and February 22nd., 2019, from 1:00 p.m. until 2:30 p.m.
