The Community Outreach SIG raises wholesome, organic produce for donation to area food banks and charities. For the past three years, over ONE TON of produce has been donated each year. Bill Greenhalgh and Leslie Hart help organise the volunteers.

Paul Barry and Margaret Seals started this SIG in 2006, using beds donated for a season at a time. The SIG now has 5 permanent beds as well as donated ones in which to raise our crops. There are two planting seasons: fall (October-March) and summer (March-September).
