PRESIDENT'S CORNER Bob Maher 2020 Photography Club President

Hi, I hope everyone is enjoying their summer, in spite of all of the COVID-19 restrictions. Speaking of COVID-19 restrictions, the Community Association has moved into what they are calling Phase 1 of 4 of reopening facilities. Phase 1 includes very limited capacity, basically 25% of what is normally allowed, hand sanitizing entering and leaving, masks, and social distancing. Use of the facilities is also limited to actual scheduled "activities" not "meetings." For us, activities would be things like training classes and workshops. Our SIGs and Discussion Groups fall in the "meetings" category. Phase 2 is basically the same, it just allows more people in the rooms. Phase 3 again increases the number of people allowed, will reduce the masks and social distancing requirements, we think, and opens the facilities to meetings. Phase 4 is the "All Clear." The CA hasn't yet provided any timeline or criteria for transitioning between the phases, but since we live in an "at risk" community, you can expect them to err on the side of caution and to significantly lag behind what the State and Local officials are doing. At least until the All Clear is declared.

The Chartered Club Committee (CCC) has been authorized by the CA Board to review any safety/transition guidelines the Chartered Clubs produce in regards to using any of the CA's facilities. Your Board has been working with the CCC to determine when and how we might be able to use the facilities. To that end, led by Walt Grabowski, we're developing a set of guidelines that will be transmitted to the membership and published on the website once completed and reviewed by the CCC. Basically, due to the severe capacity, social distancing, and sanitization requirements, the Board doesn't believe we will be able to effectively utilize the Studio (Game Rooms 1&2) during Phases 1 and 2. As the CA moves into Phase 3, and the facilities are opened to meetings, we will look at what is possible in the Studio and will likely resume General Meetings at Cowan Creek. We're also working on guidelines that would allow the PSA Print SIG and the Club's Annual Competition to occur later this year, regardless of what phase we are in.

So stay tuned. As soon as we have things finalized we will get the information out to you. In the meantime, if you've fled the Texas heat for the summer please be careful on the road. If you're like me and are toughing it out here in Central Texas, keep cool. And all of you stay safe, social distance, wash your hands, and wear a mask where appropriate. No General Meeting in July, and, right now, it looks like August's will be via Zoom. Unless we move into Phase 3 faster than is anticipated. Fingers washed and crossed. Bob Maher




