Georgetown Public Library Art Exhibit “Williamson County Through the Lens”

August 30 - September 24, 2019

The Photograph Club of Sun City will present a Photographic Exhibit Titled “Williamson County through the Lens” In the Georgetown Public Library Cafe Gallery. Our exhibit will be hung on August 30, 2019 and taken down on September 24, 2019.

The theme of the exhibit is “Williamson County Through the Lens”. The exhibit will showcase our artistic through-the-lens view of the sights, places, people, wildlife, and things we love to photograph in Georgetown and Williamson County. This leaves things pretty much open as long as it is a photo taken in Williamson County and is family friendly. **The photo entered must not have been exhibited in the Georgetown Public Library at any time in the past.**

There is available space for 28 photos with a maximum outside frame width and height of 26”. To allow as many members as possible to participate in this exhibit, the maximum dimensions must be observed. The minimum glass size is 11”x14” with a minimum picture size of 8”x10”, nothing smaller. **Photos will be accepted on a first come, first reserved basis.**

All artwork must have a strong and securely fastened wire for the artwork to hang flat. The artwork must have a label on the upper left corner of the back indicating the artist’s name, title, phone number or email, and price or “NFS”. We hope to exhibit only one photo per photographer.

Registration will begin on June 24, 2019. The last day to register is August 23, 2019 so please sign up early after registration begins.

The hang date is Friday, August 30, 2019 from 9:00am until 11:00am at the table located near the Red Poppy Coffee Co. counter in the library.

A reception will be held at the Cafe Gallery on Friday, September 13, 2019 - 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm

"Big Tex," The State Fair of Texas, has just released its 2019 "Call for Entries" for Photography in its "Creative Arts Contests" catalog.

1. 40 Categories, each with Ribbon Winners, limit one photo per category.
 - Separate Categories for Professionals
 - Separate categories for Color and Black & White
 - All photos must have been taken after Jan 1, 2018
 - Print Sizes: from 5x7 through 11x14
 - All prints to be affixed to a 11x14 mat board or foam core (No top mats nor frames, nor glass, nor metal prints, nor date or name on image.)
2. Photos must reflect scenes from Texas.
3. Entry fees per item: \$6 except Seniors which are \$2 each.
4. Submissions: Mail-In due **July 19th**
5. Entry Forms and Brochure available via CREATIVEARTS@BIGTEX.COM

If you are an artist, there is a separate Fine Arts Contest described in the same Form, etc.

Want Help Preparing Your Photo for Exhibition?

Wes Odell has offered to conduct a class that will help you prepare your image for exhibition in the annual club contest, or other venues like the Cowan Amenities Center, Legacy Grill, the Library and St. David's Hospital. The class will include an image evaluation and review for appropriateness. It will consider printing and matting issues including print sizing, offsets, balanced and unbalanced mats, styles, borders, colors and margins.

Participants in the class will receive one 16" x 20" black "standard" or "radius" profile, "Nelson Brand" frame from the American Frame company, a pre-cut commercial double mat, a back mat, glass, hanging wire and "D-Rings" Miscellaneous supplies such as glass cleaner, micro fiber towels and tapes will also be provided. You will provide the print to be framed.

The class will be conducted in three two-hour sessions and class size will be limited to no more than ten nor fewer than five. To participate, you must be a member of the Sun City Photography Club, know the basics of photo editing, know how to your image printed and be new to photo exhibiting.

Dates, times and cost of the class have not yet been determined.

Spoetzl Brewery on Sat. June 15th

The brewery, where all Shiner Beer varieties come from, is old fashioned and quaint, not all stainless steel and glass. We can watch how they make the beer, and visit their gift shop full of Shiner merchandise. Then we'll go to **Werner's Restaurant** for lunch, followed by a visit to **Sts. Cyril & Methodius Church**, which is one of the famous **Painted Churches of Texas**. Photo ops indoors and outdoors will abound. I have spoken with people at all of these places, and everything is in order. **I have received permission for us to shoot photos inside the brewery and the church -- no surprises.**

The drive is two hours each way, so **let's leave here at 8:45 AM**, arriving at the brewery close to 11:00 AM, which is the time of their first daily one-hour tour. We'll head down the street to Werner's around noon for lunch. Then we can go to the church sometime between 1:00-2:00. If we finish at the church around 3:30-4:00 and head home, we can be back to Sun City close to 6:00 PM. How's that for an exact schedule?

We are car pooling for this trip. I will drive my own car with room for 3 more people. We will need 1 or 2 other cars, depending on how many people sign up for the trip. I will provide some maps, along with background information about the brewery and the church that you can read during the drive down there

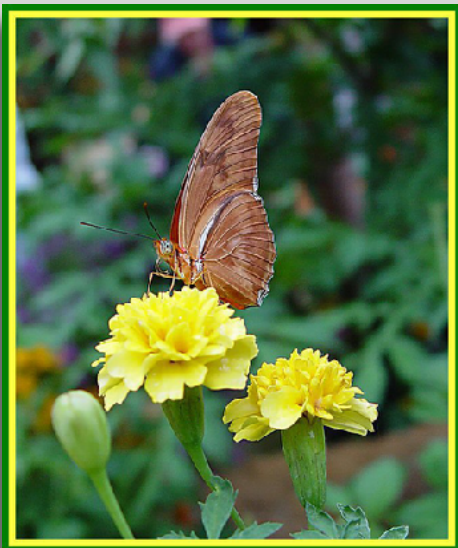

June's Theme: Water and/or Sand

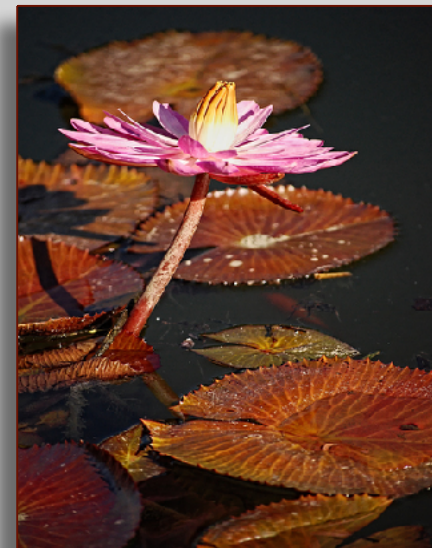

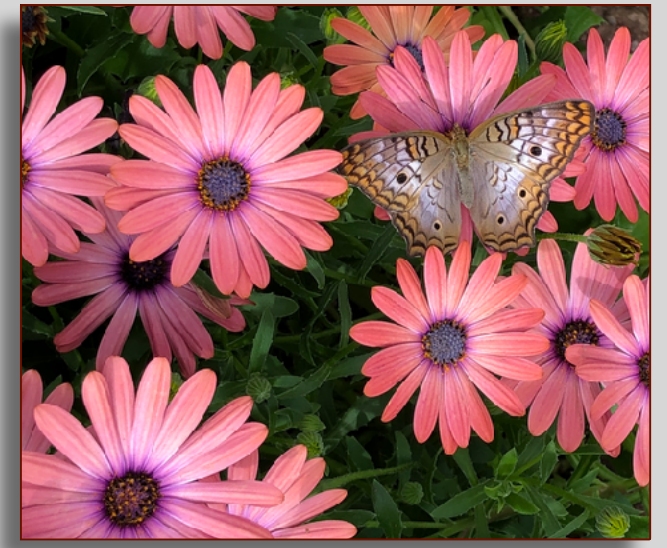
