### TREASURER'S REPORT

July 2019 Financial Summary

The Club began the month of July with a balance of \$9,022 and ended with \$8,868 for a net loss of \$154.00. Income totaled \$190 all from new memberships. Expenses totaled \$344.00 which included court cameras of \$77.00, Ice Cream Social of \$158.00 and \$24.00 for Club Pickleball Mixer refreshments. Expenses also included \$85.00 printing and supply costs for the Pickleball Display at Texas Drive Social Center and miscellaneous administrative needs of the Club.

We had 38 new members bringing our total to 652.


# THANKS!

# FROM OUR DISTRICT AMBASSADOR



#### Line Calls and Knowing the Rules

I just returned from the South Atlantic Regional Tournament, in Alabama, where I was asked a

question about line calling and I thought it would be good topic for this month's "Kitchen Talk." During a match, a player from Team A hit a ball out. However, a player from Team B returned it (without calling it, "OUT!") Since the ball was still being played, the other Team A player hit it back again where the other Team B player hit it into the net. At that point, this Team B player pointed out that the first ball in this narrative had been, 'out,' and they should be the winners of this rally. After quite a bit of discussion, the referee agreed and awarded to point to Team B.

There are several failures here. First, if the Team B players saw the ball as, 'out,' they were required to make that call; a) before a member of the other team hit it, or, b) before the ball became dead (See Rule 6.D.8.). The second failure is (apparently) none of the players or the referee knew this very basic rule of line calling. The third failure was that the members of Team A did not know of (or remember) Rule 13.I. This rule permits a player to request that the referee, head referee, or tournament director show the applicable rule in the rule book. Had they done that, Team A would have been awarded the point.
