LUCY OXBERRY BIO:

Lucy Oxberry was born in Prague, Czechslovakia and came to the USA as a child after escaping from the Communist that overtook her country. Her family settled in Washington, DC, where she began her exploration into art. She graduated Valedictorian in the Fine Arts Department at Marjorie Webster College in DC. From there she spent the next seven years happily flying for American Airlines. After Marriage, she moved to San Diego and earned a Masters Degree and began teaching Special Education, as well as teaching art to middle and high school students. Ever since she could hold a pencil and crayons, Lucy have been drawing and was deeply inspired by her Great Uncle, Vaclav Radimsky, (1867-1946) who shared a studio with Paul Cezanne in Paris then lived for 28 years near Giverny, France, painting with his friend, Claud Monet. He is credited as being one of the artists who brought Impressionistic Painting to Czechoslovakia.

Currently Lucy is teaching three drawing classes at 3 different levels, each a series. Basic Drawing I is a series of three classes, and is the basis for all the following drawing classes, and should be taken first. Drawing II and Drawing III are sequential classes, each a series of six classes, one per week. Lucy also teaches a monthly unique Step-by-Step Acrylic Painting Class especially
