## **Direct Connectivity**

In general you can typically pair up to 5 devices to your hearing aids. The order in which you pair them will determine the "pecking order" in which they are recognized.

IF you have alerts turned on (email, text, Pintrest board updates) you will hear those through your hearing aids. Sorry, can't change that.

Manufacturers currently have "Direct Connectivity Helplines" for patient support.



## Rechargeable Hearing Aids

There are currently two options here, Lithium-Ion and Z-Power retrofit kits.

**Z-Power** was widely hyped, and is severely underperforming. In my opinion, not worth the hassle or the money.

Usage on a rechargeable battery will depend on your use day and how much you stream from another device. The more you stream, the less time on the charge.








#### **Tele-Audiology Support**

Currently there are 4:6 manufacturers that have the capability for this type of support depending on the device you are wearing. Starkey, ReSound, Signia, & Phonak have this built into the newest chipset. Some older models may have this ability for remote programming. Oticon will be rolling this out, which leaves Widex as the only one that does not currently have a solution.

This can allow for routine adjustments and follow-up to be performed in the comfort of your home with the use of your smart device.
