Windows 10

- The latest rumor kicking around is that Windows 10 will be RTM (released to manufacture) in July of 2015
- The release date has not been confirmed by Microsoft
- It is clear that we are getting very close to the release date
- Conventional thinking is that Win 10 will come as a free update, for Win 7
 & 8.X Users, as long as they update within the first year following release of Win 10
- Beginning in May I am going to use Windows 10, in the SIG so that you will become familiar with the operating system

- We have frequently talked about the difficulty in accessing troubleshooting options in Win 8.X (e.g. Safe Mode, System Restore, Refresh etc.)
- We have previously offered several Band-Aids for specific functions which still makes access difficult and an adventure
- Here's the best and most comprehensive yet!
 - ➤ Simply depress the Shift key (hold it down) and click "Re-Start"
 - ➤ When the system reboots you will have all the options at your disposal, in one place
 - Try it, it works in Win 8.X and already works in Win 10!

Simple Tips for Resolving Slow Wi-Fi Networks

- 1. Routers get "indigestion", simply un-plug the power on the router, wait for a minute, reinsert the power and your system will reset
- 2. Because modern routers cast their signal in a "circle", if your router is located on an "outer wall" you have effectively lost ½ of the range so placement of your router is doubly important. The guidance is to place the router at eye level or higher!
- 3. Understand the Wi-Fi traffic in your area. Download a free tool... http://www.nirsoft.net/utils/wifi information view.html
 - This tool will provide a plethora of information about who is using which channels in your area and switching to a less crowded channel can boost performance
 - Every person who employs wireless should have WifiInfoView installed on their system, here's the link... http://www.nirsoft.net/utils/wifiinfoview.zip
- 4. When replacing your router, newer routers are designated "AC" and feature faster speeds, dual networks (2.4 & 5 G) and "other" features

- It's a free download at www.Ninite.com under the header "Media"
- The 2.2.x version has just been released and contains many more codecs than other players which almost guarantees, fewer problems
- VLC even functions as a media server for streaming, and
- Even permits a User to re-play a video from where they stopped
- VLC is a exceptional player and it is suggested that you give it a try!

BVCKUP 2

- One of the many problems with backups is, when needed they don't work!
- As a result I have for several years resorted to multiple backups, in an attempt to ensure that one will work
- One of the backups that I employ is BVCKUP 2
 - ➤ It is a "files and folder" backup only, no programs
 - ➤ It's very fast
 - > Files are not compressed or encrypted
 - ➤ Will backup to any location and multiple locations (e.g. flash, cloud or external drives)
 - ➤ By default, backs up new files and changes every six hours
- The cost... \$20 per year 1st copy, 10% discount for second copy, two week free trial
- If you are backup challenged I suggest you try BVCKUP 2, here's the link... https://www.bvckup2.com/


