How To... Retrieve Windows & MS Office License Keys

- It is very important that you have a “hard copy” record of your license keys
- Nirsoft is a trusted provider and makes it easy to retrieve your license keys, with a free program
- You can download the program at this link...
http://www.nirsoft.net/utils/product_cd_key_viewer.html
- Page down towards the bottom of the page to the link entitled “Download Produkey”, click and save the file to your hard drive
- Some malware programs identify “produkey” as malware because of what it does and it is not!
- Unzip the file, if your security settings prevent produkey from running, turn off your security temporally or boot into Safe Mode to retrieve your keys
- Make a hard copy record of your license keys and store in a safe place

CES at Las Vegas

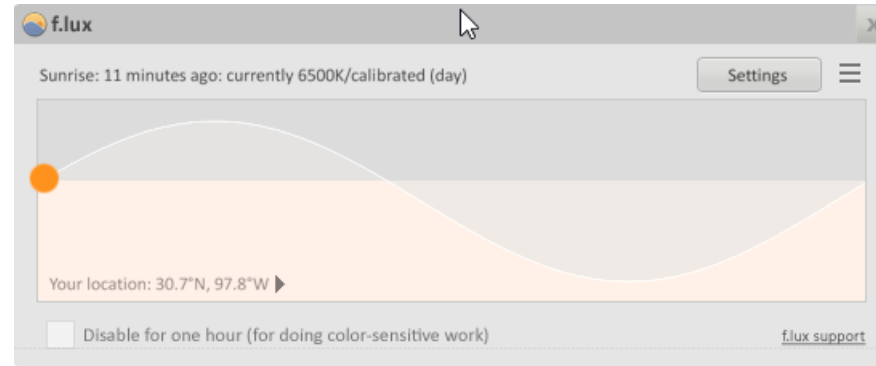
- The CES meeting is held each year at the Las Vegas Convention Center

F.Lux

- This app makes sense, it's free, uses minimal resources, install it, it's automatic thereafter
- The color of your desktop display automatically adapts to time of day

Snipping Tool

- One of the more useful apps that comes with Windows is the “Snipping Tool”
- It permits the customized capture of pictures and text
- Graphics that you see at the SIG are captured with the Snipping Tool
- The Snipping Tool is free and comes with the Windows Operating System
- It’s accessible as follows:
 - Windows 7, click Start > it’s on the programs list > click to open
 - Windows 8.x, go to the Start page, type... Snipping Tool > click to open
- In both apps you can right click and pin to the Taskbar for easy access

Windows Insider Program

What is the Microsoft Insider Program?

- It's a way to help shape the future of and development of the Windows operating system
- It's a way of becoming aware of the new features in Windows 10 by participating in the "Community"
- It's a way of getting access to early releases of Windows 10
- It requires a sign in with a Microsoft ID, here's the link
