

### **CONTROLLERS SHOULD BE TURNED OFF**

It is that time again! We need to turn our controllers **OFF**. Our grass will not need watering until early spring. Please notify your neighborhood to turn their Controllers to “**OFF**”. Plants can be watered manually, if needed, through the winter months.

### **SPRINKLER WINTERIZATION**

We continue to get inquiries from residents about “winterization” of their systems. We advise them that their system piping is buried in the ground and that soil depth should protect their system in normal Central Texas winters.

If there is a projected long term cold spell forecast, your Water Matters Team will advise all our Water Ambassadors of steps to be taken to assist our residents in protecting their systems.

Since most “Drip” irrigation is not buried as deep in the ground as mainline and lateral piping, it is vulnerable to cold weather. If the resident has turned off their “Drip” zones, the water should have evaporated or leaked out of the tubing. Most problems exist in the PVC fittings. These items tend to freeze in very cold weather.

### **PLEASE DO NOT REPAIR ANY PART OF A HOMEOWNER’S SPRINKLER SYSTEM**

Only the homeowner (HO) or a person licensed by the State of Texas can perform such duties as repairing or modifying an irrigation system. Water Ambassadors can educate the (HO) on how to use his/her controller. The Evaluator can help the HO test his/her system and to flag any problem areas.
