1. **Add a picture to your N48 website profile.** It's so easy to change your appearance from a blank to your personal photo:
 - a. Find a picture you want to use for the photo
 - b. Log on to the Sun City Website
 - c. Under "Resident Home" click on "My Profile" and update your photo and other information as appropriate. Further instructions can be found at "My Neighborhood" under "How to Add Your Profile Photo."



(Note: Although a personal picture of yourself is preferred, we understand a few of you may have reasons for not posting a personal photo online. If that is the case, please consider using a replacement photo such as your cat, your hobby, your initials or other picture, so N48 is aware you've given thought to the photo, but elect not to post one. Also, by doing so, you can eliminate the "hounding" you may continue to receive asking you to post your photo.

2. **Wear your name badge to neighborhood events.** It's such an easy thing to do and yet many of us tend to forget. Let's resolve this year to help out our new neighbors (as well as all of us forgetful neighbors) by wearing a name badge at N48 events. Keep it handy...i.e., near your garage door to easily grab when you exit, or simply put it on every day when you dress then you won't forget. Just kidding...but let's try harder this year to remember our name badges.
