### <u>Tuesday, October 18, 10 am – 2 pm</u> HIKE, FISH AND LUNCH AT GAREY PARK



Hey N48ers! Join your neighbors at Georgetown's Garey Park on Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>. We will meet at the park at 10:00 a.m. There is a small entry fee of \$1 per person for Sun City residents. Please use the parking lot just past the ponds, in the northeast corner of the lot so we can have an area to sit and enjoy our lunches. There are scattered picnic tables throughout the park if you choose to eat elsewhere.

During our visit, you will have the option to hike, fish, or just join your neighbors for lunch. The park has nine trails, with the majority of them being easy to moderate, with distances from 0.22 miles to 2.3 miles. As you enter the park, ask for a Trail Map, as it has important information on the trails as well as points of interest. Be sure to wear comfortable walking shoes and bring water!

Garey Park has two stocked fishing ponds for catch-and-release fishing. The ponds are stocked with bass, catfish, and sunfish. You are welcome to fish before, during, or after our group hikes. Please bring your fishing equipment; however, Boyd will bring extra equipment (rods, reels, and tackle) for those in need. Everyone should bring their own

sack lunch and drinks. Please bring chairs (and a table if desired) since we will be eating close to where we are parked. We will eat at approximately noon. There are also restrooms near where we are dining.

Please register online by Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup> so we know how many people to expect. If you would like to carpool, check the registration list online to contact others about riding together. Hope to see you there! #### A Great Household Tip from Dave Rowland

Does your under-cabinet lighting generate a lot of heat? If so, you can replace the Halogen light bulbs with LED bulbs! Below is a photo of both bulbs.

Dave says their home has under-cabinet lighting fixtures with 1-3 bulbs in each fixture. When he and Denise moved in, they found the wall cabinet bottom surface was very hot just above the light fixture. He found the fixtures had G9 Type Halogen bulbs that consume a lot of energy and generate significant heat. He found a G9 LED bulb to replace these bulbs. #### Sun City Street Maintenance Starts Monday, Sept. 26

The City of Georgetown will start street maintenance in Neighborhoods 48-59 and 64 on Monday, Sept. 26. The production schedule is weather-dependent, and if there are delays, the city will update the community. If rain occurs on roads scheduled for that day, then that road will be pushed to the end of the schedule. (I am not including the map link, which was hard to read, but Martin Creek from Pedernales through Copperas Creek Cove is scheduled for Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, and the very end of

Martin Creek and all of Coffee Mill Creek is scheduled on Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>.)



All street closures will be from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. During this time, all vehicular access (cars and golf carts), including street parking, will be prohibited on streets where maintenance work is being performed. Move vehicles to open streets on the day your street will be undergoing the sealant application.
