HOW TO USE THE APPLE PHOTOS APP ON YOUR IPHONE

Overview:

To fully enjoy the benefits of the **Apple Ecosystem** with your iPhone, you should understand the fundamental relationship between the **CAMERA APP**, the PHOTOS APP, and iCLOUD.

First. Every-time you take a photo with your iPhone or iPad camera, the resulting image is **found** in the PHOTOS APP. The **Photos App manages the storage and editing for all images shot on the iPhone or iPad (or imported into the Photos app on those devices)**.

Second, The **Apple iCloud enables** all your iDevices to **share images** and to back up your images. By iDevices I mean: iPhone, iPad, Apple TV & Watch, and the MAC. Therefore, I recommend that you **Turn ON "iCloud Photos" in Settings for the Photos App on all your iDevices.**

Third, The best integration of images is achieved when you use a Mac rather than a PC to manage your photo library. **The Mac functions as an iDevice and provides the best environment for photo editing and the fullest integration into the Apple Ecosystem.** Every Mac sold is loaded with Apple Photos and is ready and able to support your photo library.
