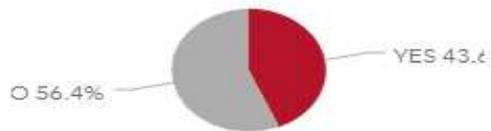




City of Georgetown Debris Removal Efforts

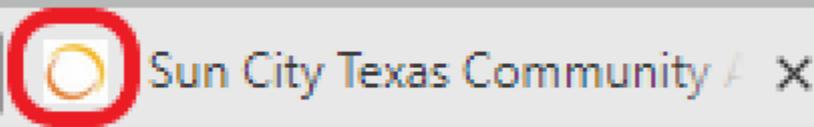
- Communities Overregulating Networks Need Economic Competition

The CONNECT Act, or “Communities Overregulating Networks Need Economic Competition” will supposedly not affect existing municipal broadband services, but is written to prevent cities and states from forming their own broadband networks unless “there is no more than one other commercial provider of broadband internet access that provides competition for that service in a particular area,” the bill states. Additionally, existing municipal broadband networks would be prohibited from expanding their network into new areas.

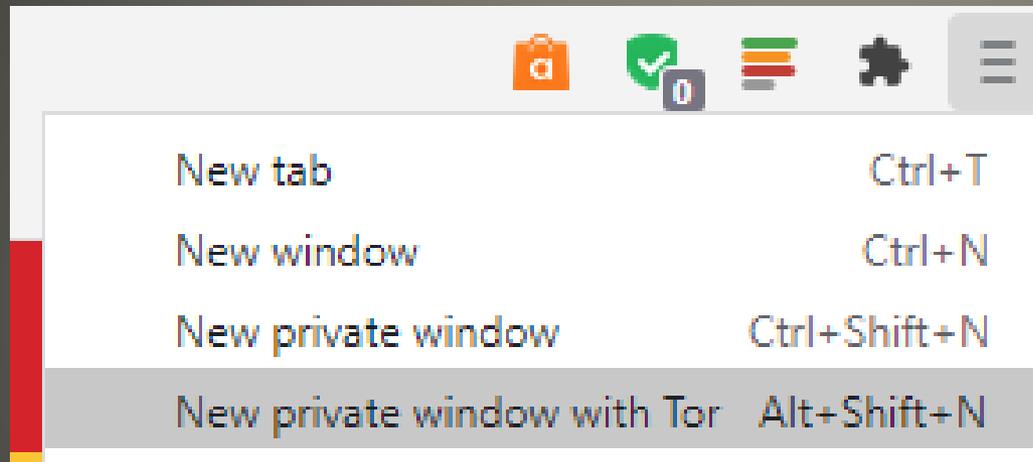

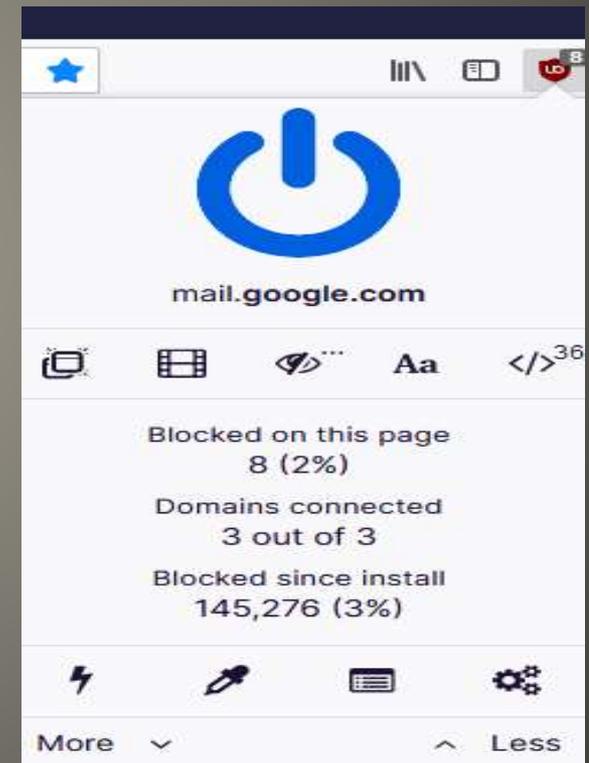

Windows Update



Highlights

- Updates an issue that displays unexpected screens during the Windows Out of Box Experience (OOBE).
- Updates an issue in Advanced display settings that shows the incorrect refresh rates available for high dynamic range (HDR) displays.
- Updates an issue that might cause video playback to flicker when rendering on certain low-latency capable monitors.
- Updates an issue that sometimes prevents the input of strings into the Input Method Editor (IME).
- Updates an issue that might sometimes prevent some keyboard keys from working, such as the home, Ctrl, or left arrow keys. This issue occurs when you set the Japanese IME input mode to Kana.
- Updates an issue that displays the wrong language when you sign in to a console after you change the system locale.
- Updates an issue with screen rendering after opening games with certain hardware configurations.
- Displays the proper Envelope media type as a selectable output paper type for Universal Print queues.
- Updates support for hole punch and stapling locations for print jobs with long edge first paper feed direction on certain printers.

Omnibox - Use HTTPS as the default protocol for navigations

Use HTTPS as the default protocol when the user types a URL without a protocol in the omnibox such as 'example.com'. Presently, such an entry navigates to http://example.com. When this feature is enabled, it will navigate to https://example.com if the HTTPS URL is available. If Chrome can't determine the availability of the HTTPS URL within the timeout, it will fall back to the HTTP URL. – Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS, Android

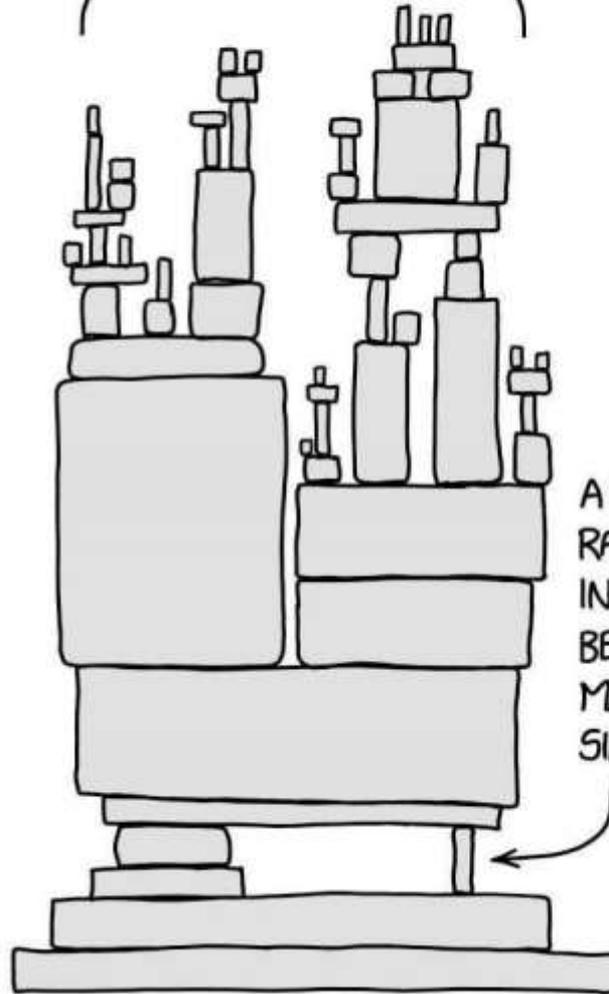

During beta, users can expect to see data speeds vary from 50Mb/s to 150Mb/s and latency from 20ms to 40ms in most locations over the next several months as we enhance the Starlink system. There will also be brief periods of no connectivity at all.

As we launch more satellites, install more ground stations and improve our networking software, data speed, latency and uptime will improve dramatically.

The Starlink team will provide periodic updates on availability as we launch more satellites and expand our coverage area. Depending on your location, some orders may take 6 months or more to fulfill.

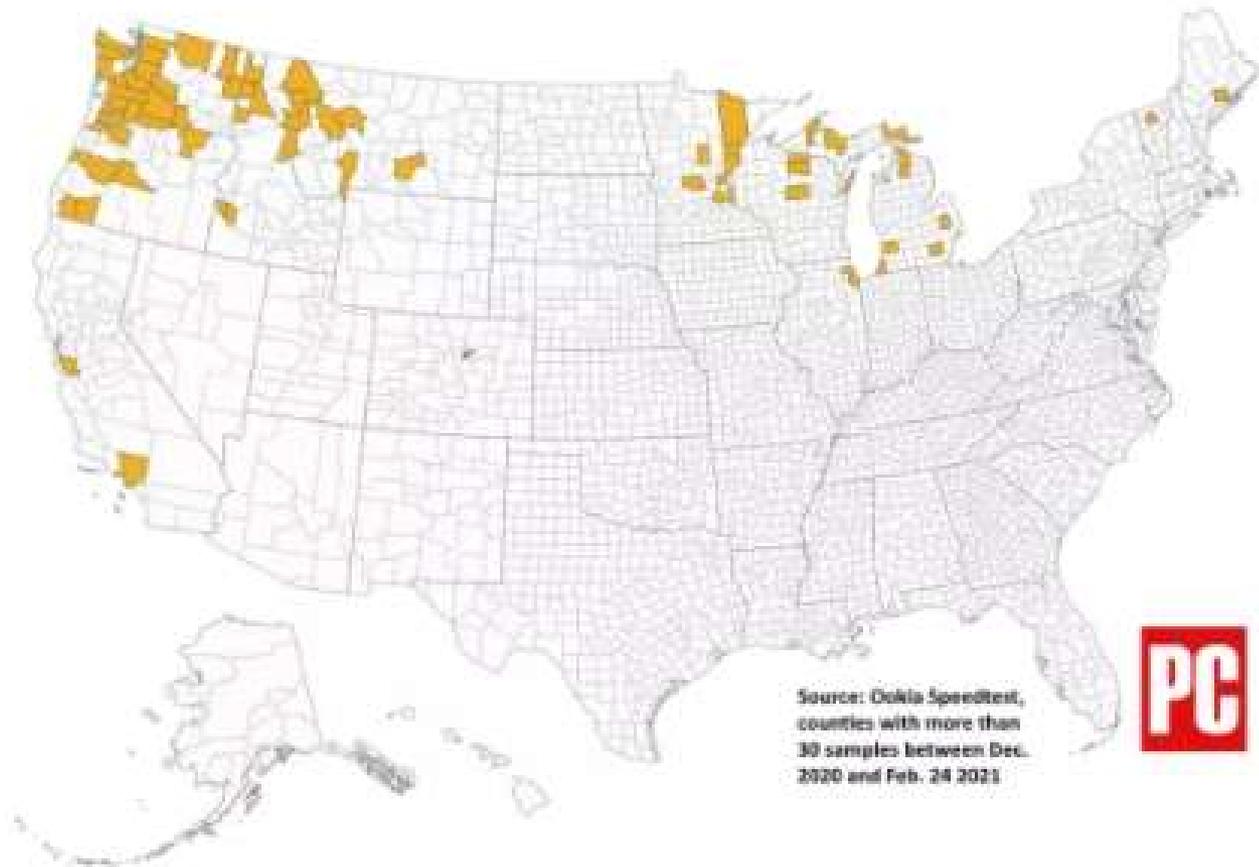

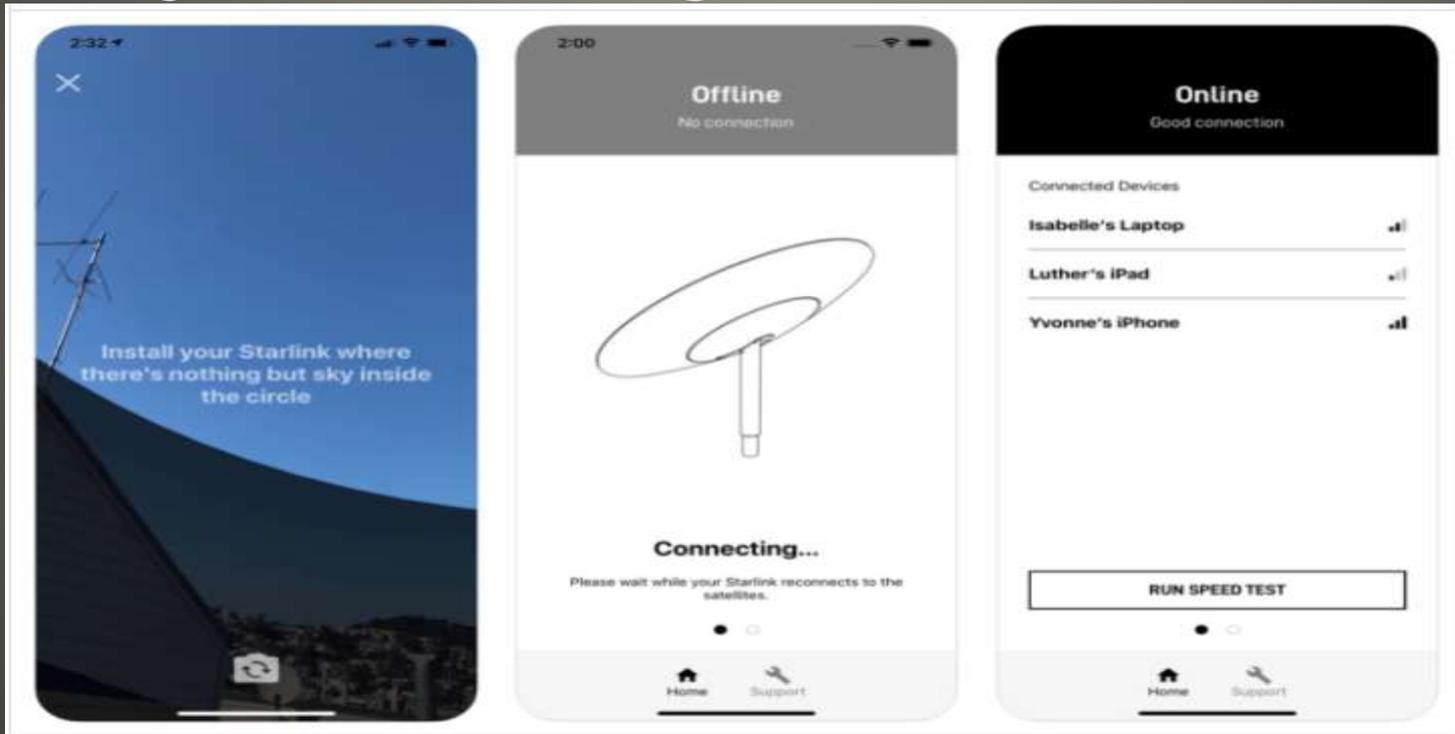
Where Americans Use Starlink Now

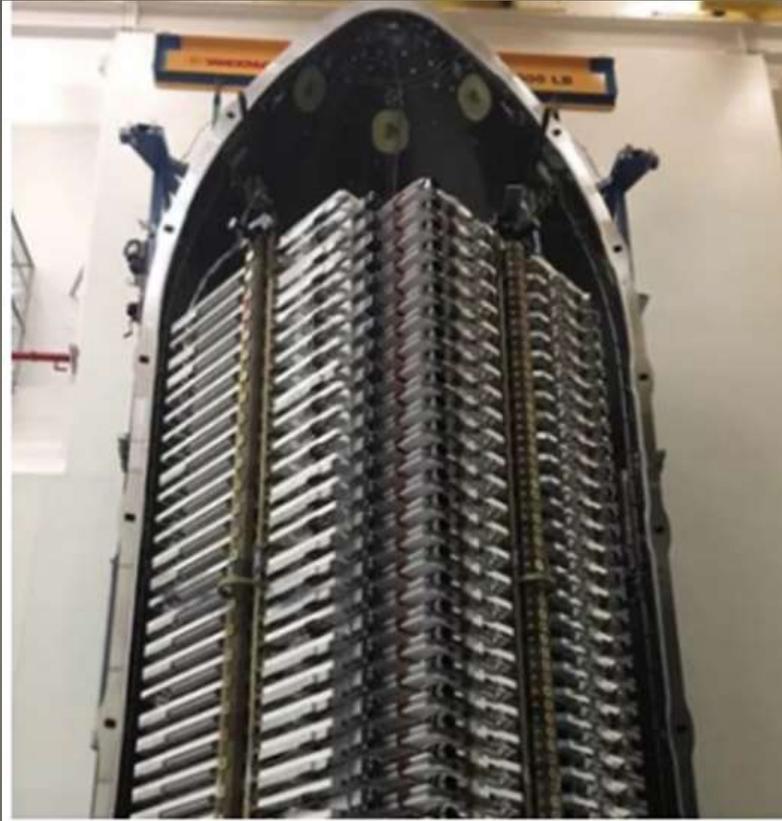

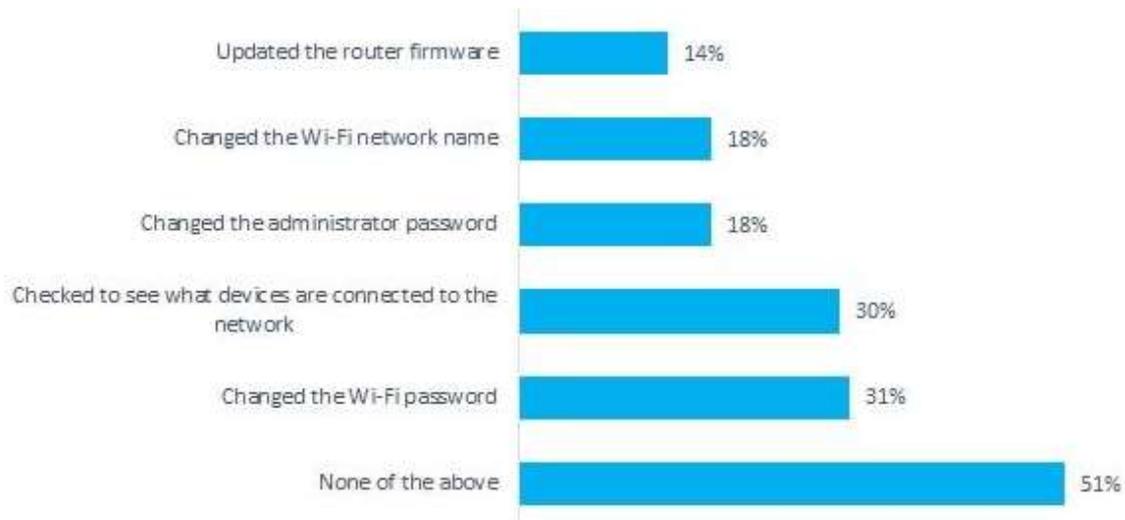

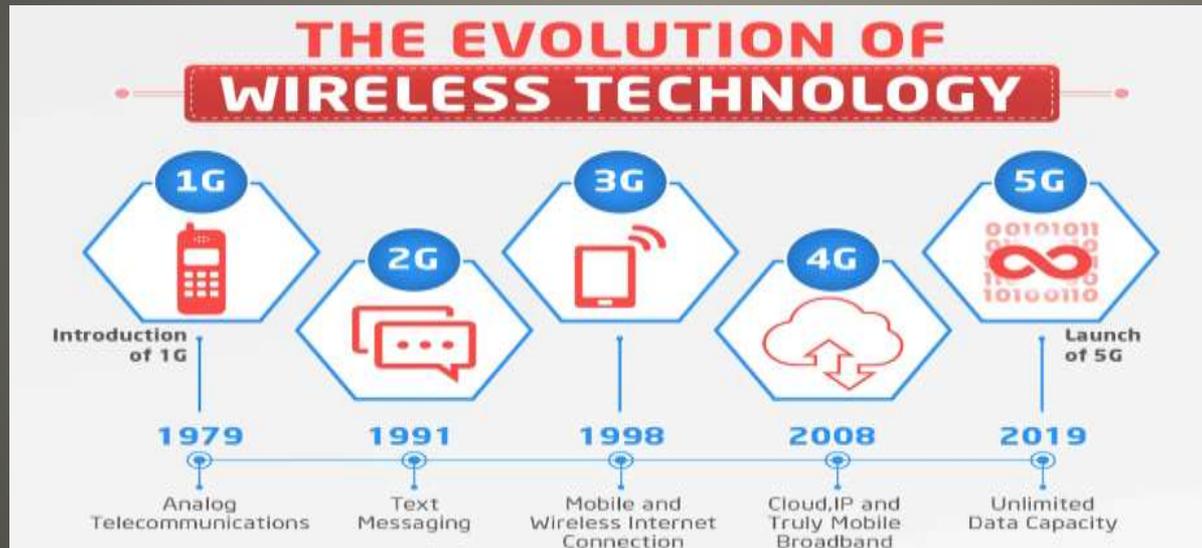

5G



- New *type* of network
- Connect *everything*



5G



- Low latency < 1 ms
- High call density 100x
- Cell towers -> light poles
- 10% decrease in energy to power

- Cost to establish
- Limited coverage
- Crowded spectrum
- Huawei & geopolitical
- Weather forecasting

- Frequency – non-ionizing?
