- Some phones, encrypted SD card
- USB lock via settings
- Like devices may encrypt
- Cloud may encrypt
- Backup may encrypt
- Chat
 - WhatsApp, Signal, Telegraph, Wire
- Convenience trumps security/secretcy
- 2 or more, secretcy?
