## TEXAS UIL RECLASSIFICATIONS AND REALIGNMENT

## FOR 2014-15 and 2015-2016

The announcement that every high school athlete and coach was waiting for was released at 9am on Monday, February 3, 2014. Every two years the Texas UIL makes changes in the classification of Texas high schools for major sports based on attendance. In addition, they realign the schools into Regions and Districts based on location and other schools in the area. A big change this time is that a new class 6A has been created. Most schools that were 5A will now be $6 \mathrm{~A}, 4 \mathrm{~A}$ will be $5 \mathrm{~A}, 3 \mathrm{~A}$ will be $4 \mathrm{~A}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$ will be 3 A , etc. Classes 4 A and down will also be divided into two Divisions.

Georgetown High and Georgetown East View have been classified as 5A for the 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 school years. Both of these schools have been moved into Region 4, District 25. Below is the detail information on the schools they will be completing with in district play.

This is a change of class, district and region for the Georgetown schools. So at the end of this school year it is farewell to Bastrop, Bastrop Cedar Creek, Elgin, Hutto, Manor, and Pflugerville Connally schools.

Elgin, Hutto, Manor, and Pflugerville Connally are now 5A, but remain in District 17 joined by Temple, Waco and Waco University.

Bastrop and Bastrop Cedar Creek are now 5A, but have been moved from District 17 to District 26 in Region 4 to join six Austin schools - Crockett, Johnson, Lanier, McCallum, Reagan and Travis. Austin Eastside Memorial will also play in this district for basketball only.

Leander Rouse moved up to class 6A and moved from District 25 to District 13 to join Pflugerville, Pflugerville Hendrickson, and five Round Rock schools - Round Rock, Cedar Ridge, McNeil, Stony Point and Westwood.

All of the above applies to Football and Basketball. In general it will apply to Baseball, Softball and Volleyball. But, for some of the other sports such as Soccer, Wrestling, Swimming, etc. may differ because of the number of schools participating in those sports.
