



The Toxic Windows Freeware Ecosystem

- The "freeware" system is broken and if you download anything from the likes of e.g.
 - ✓ Download.com
 - ✓ Cnet.com, or
 - ✓ Click on Glary application updates
 - ✓ Or virtually any other freeware website, you're asking for trouble!
- Practically every piece of freeware is stuffed with junk!
- If you try to avoid download sites and "google" e.g. "VLC player"... you are pointed to a myriad of sites that serve up adware-filled junk installers
- That is why we recommend www.ninite as your primary site for free software. Ninite is not technically a freeware site, it is more a site for techs to setup and maintain computers. Ninite is the only safe site for Windows downloads that we are aware of!
- If you cannot find an app on Ninite, go only to the vendors website, make sure that is where you are, go slow and read before you click

Apps for Your Consideration

- 1. The apps on the first page that follows are all available, free at www.ninite.com
- 2. Ninite is the safest place to download malware free apps
- 3. Several apps that are needed should be secured only from the vendor source
- 4. Sometimes accessing the vendor source can be an adventure
- 5. The second page attempts to provide you with the app and the safe URL
- 6. Even then, it is very import that you slow down and read before you click!

- (1.) When you understand that no malware program provides total security, it leads to try free options 1st
- (2.) Microsoft Security Essentials is a free antivirus program, that uses few system resources
- (3.) Guidance is to employ one malware program, malware programs typically employ enormous resources
- (4.) WOT is effective in flagging dangerous websites, install on each browser
- (5.) AdwCleaner is a one time use app and must be re-installed/download for repeated use

(1.) Early on we found that if CCleaner and Glary were run, that each found a large amount of trash, so we recommended both. As time has passed, CCleaner has gone thru numerous updates and as a result CCleaner fines more trash and Glary less. There are issues with Glary's program update app that results in malware (all 3rd party program update apps have issues). If you choose to employ Glary use "one click maintenance" only!
