from Wearing Unitron Moxi North Pro Hearing Aids for 1 Week

Jim Burton – Jim has been wearing Starkey, in-the-canal aids for 8 years. They have served him well, but as you can imagine, he isn't hearing real well now – 8 years later. He has been quite happy with the new technology of the Unitron aids; however the change from aids in-the-canal to behind-the-ear has been challenging. His glasses, and his sunshades that fit over his glasses, displace the hearing aid and causes the dome to come out of his ear. He is going to investigate this problem further, as Unitron also makes aids that fit in-the-canal. Look at the attached Power Point presentation for many different types of Unitron aids available through Dr. Jill Mendez.

Jane Owens – Jane has advanced degree is audiology & has taught & counseled children & parents regarding hearing loss. She experienced some increased understanding of speech with the Unitron aids but not in all situations. She and Dr. Mendez agreed that her loss is not great enough at this time to select aids but will check again in a year.

Bill Papineau – Bill doesn't presently wear aids. After a few days of wearing the aids, he thought they were not working well at all. He discovered the batteries were dead, as he hadn't been told to open the battery compartment at night when he wasn't wearing them. His hearing loss is severe, and he has tinnitus, in his left ear. He wasn't able to adjust volume & tinnitus settings precisely because he had no Unitron accessories. Sounds like crunching tinfoil, turning pages of magazine & combing hair were unusually loud. He could hear TV at lower volumes; improvement in distinguishing dialogue was limited. Plans to try other type aids (CIC & Full Shell) for comparison of hearing & comfort. He found Dr. Mendez to be very professional & personable and very easy to work with – no sales pressure whatsoever. "I am concerned about the cost."

Ann Morgan – Ann has never worn hearing aids but realizes she does not hear well. She has tried several brand aids; all have provided no solution even though a particular audiologist went to extreme efforts with adjustments. Unitron has brought better hearing and understanding than any others. She is encouraged and will work with Dr. Mendez for the best adjustments.




