#### Safety Thought:

If you have a medical emergency, having the following documents in a safe place ready to give to Emergency Responders or to take with you can be critical:

- \* Health insurance cards (can be copy)
- \* Advance Directive also know as Directive to Physician or Living Will
- \* Do Not Resuscitate Form if needed
- \* A photo of yourself such as a copy of Driver's license or ID card
- \* A list of your current doctors, with contact information
- \* A list of current medications
- \* Emergency contact information form
- \* Emergency contacts
- \* Insurance papers and any necessary paperwork for an emergency

Place the items in a folder or plastic bag and store in an readily accessible place.
