### USAA Insurance and Firewise USA Cooperate

Firewise Town Hall October 4, 9:30 am

The Sun City Texas Firewise program is in it's eight year. When it began, there were about 700 Firewise communities in the USA. Today there is over 1300. There was concern about the dangers of wildfire and its possible effect on Sun City Texas. Firewise has evolved both in Sun City Texas and the nation. It is now going international. SCT is evolving into a showcase for how Firewise concepts can be applied to a wildland/urban environment like our's.

A major development has been the cooperation between Firewise USA and USAA insurance to define and justify a reduction in homeowner's insurance premium. In fact, USAA visited Sun City Texas as they were researching the outcomes attributed to wildfire losses when Firewise concepts were applied to communities.

Firewise USA representatives and Rob Galbraith, Director of Property Underwriting at USAA will be attending our Town Hall.

Firewise USA has been invited to provide an update of the current Firewise program.

Rob will be discussing USAA's research showing that Firewise measurably reduces the risk of loss due to a wildfire event and what USAA is doing to promote their Firewise discount. He will also discuss the importance of Ready, Set, Go – having a plan for you and your family to evacuate in case of a wildfire,
