FROM YOUR USAPA DISTRICT AMBASSADOR





USAPA PLACES TO PLAY

As most of you know, this is January. Well, it was when I wrote this for the February issue of "Kitchen Talk". January is an important month for the USA Pickleball Association (USAPA). That's the month that the pickleball ambassadors update all the venues listed on the USAPA "Places to Play" web page. There were 4,747 listed on the web site as of December 31st of last year. That's a lot of places to individually contact in order to ensure that the information listed is accurate and current. Fortunately, we have a bunch of dedicated people who have volunteered

to be ambassadors to promote our sport. There are 161 places in Texas on this list, 60 of which are in the Central & South Central Texas district. The good news (for me) is that I have 29 local ambassadors, spread across the state from San Angelo to McAllen. That spreads the load and makes this all possible.

Updating these sites is one of the most important tasks that ambassadors perform. The Places to Play list is one of the 'go-to' sites for traveling players and having accurate information about the play days and times, as well as valid contact information, can make visits to new venues a very enjoyable experience. I've personally used the site many times. Whether it was accompanying Elaine to visit her mom in the Chicago area or to attend a dulcimer festival in St Louis, it was a way to keep me out of the way and out of trouble...but not always "out of the kitchen!"


