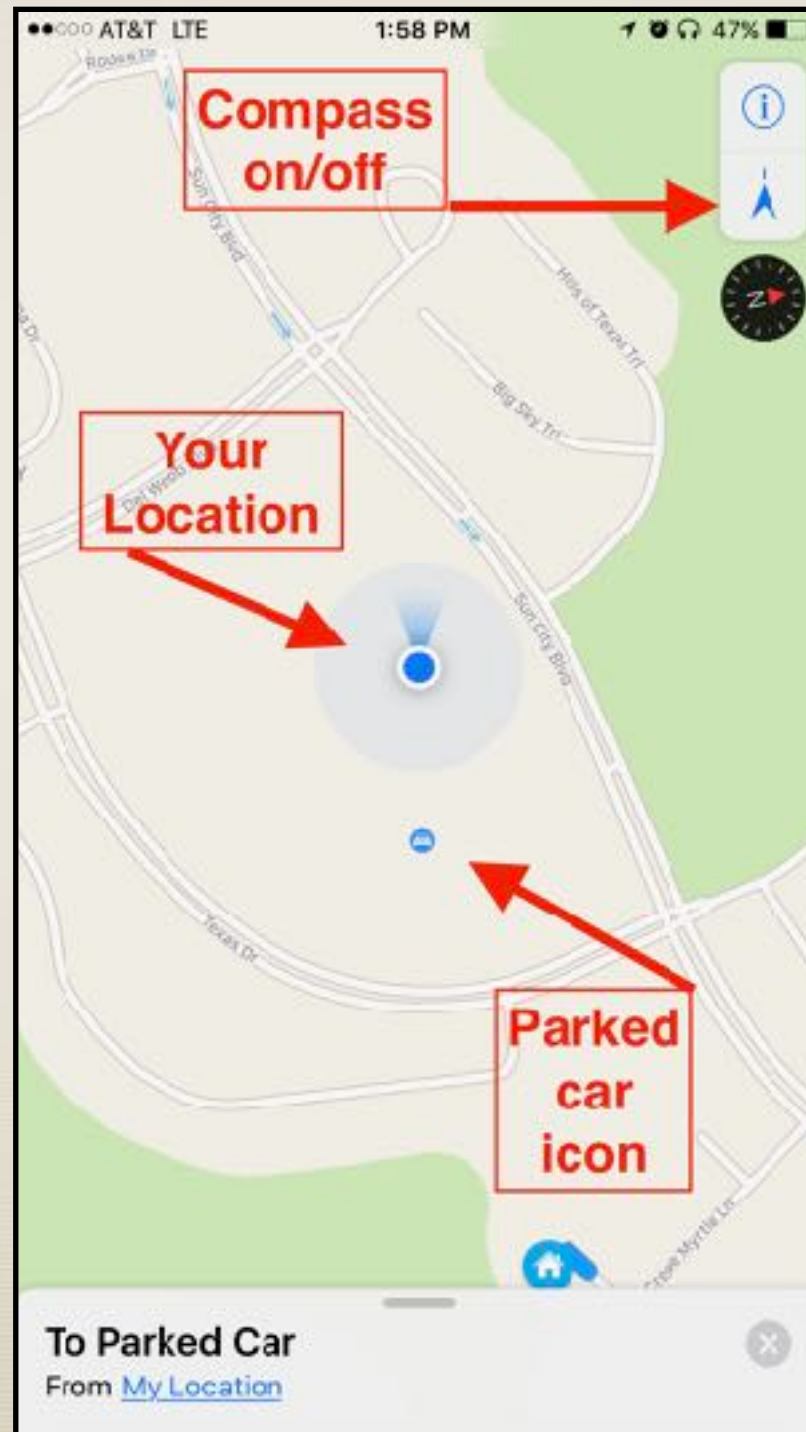

Automatically Mark Your Parked Car in Maps

- * iPhone must have bluetooth enabled
- * Your car must have bluetooth and be paired to your phone
- * When you turn off the ignition, Apple Maps drops a pin in your location.
- * Open Maps to help locate your parked car

Automatically Mark Your Parked Car in Maps

- * Helpful in many places
- * Street parking in new area
- * HEB
- * Social Center



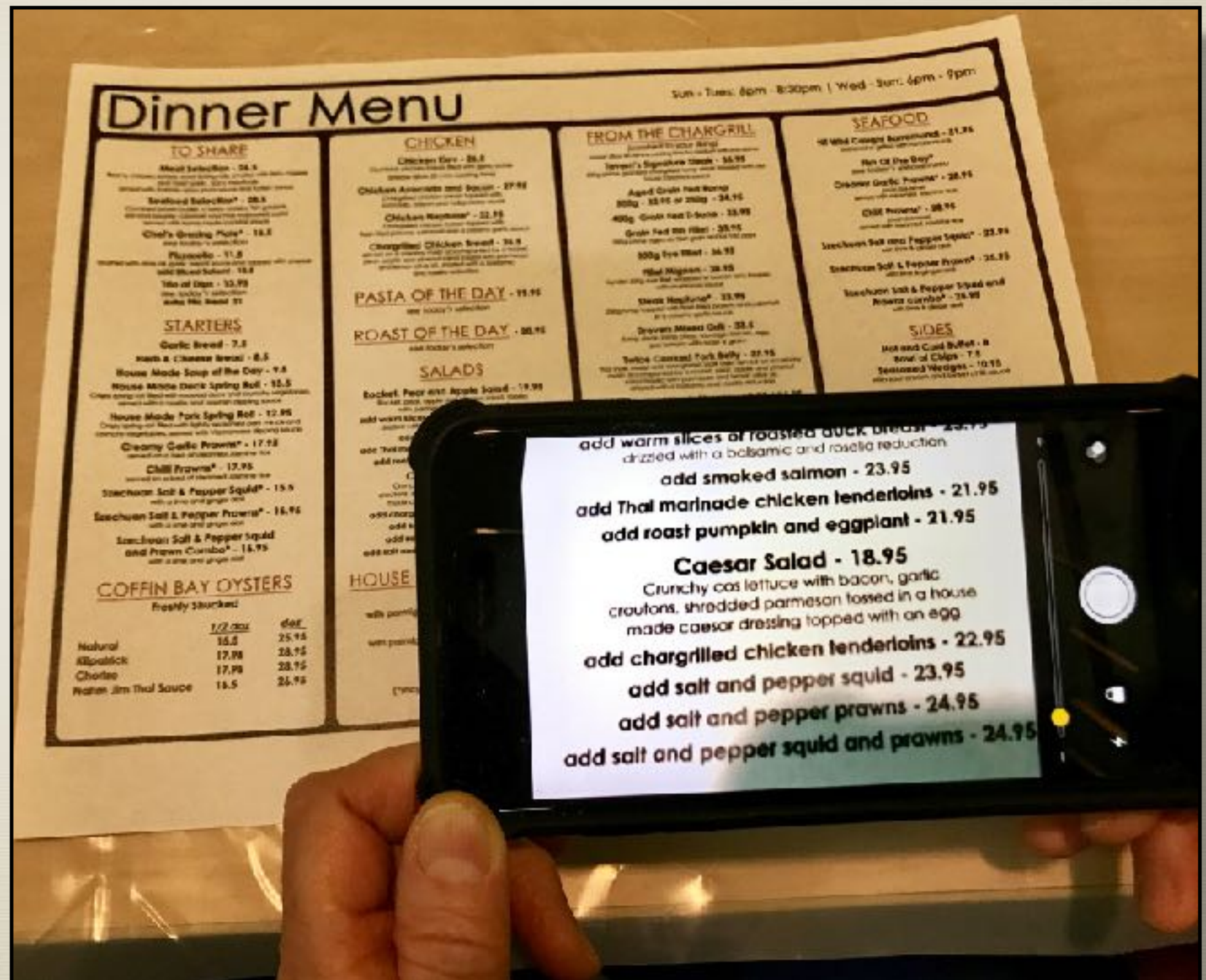
Location Based Reminders

- * Hey Siri: Remind me to go to Walgreens
 - * When I get home or leave home
 - * Requires Siri 'My Info' pointing to your contact
 - * When I get in or out of the car
 - * Requires Bluetooth turned on and iPhone paired to your car
- * Hey Siri: Remind me to do something when I get to, or leave any address, contact name or business name



Magnifying Glass

- * Settings > General > Accessibility > Magnifier > ON
- * Triple click home button
- * Adjust the zoom, tap to focus, use the flash if needed

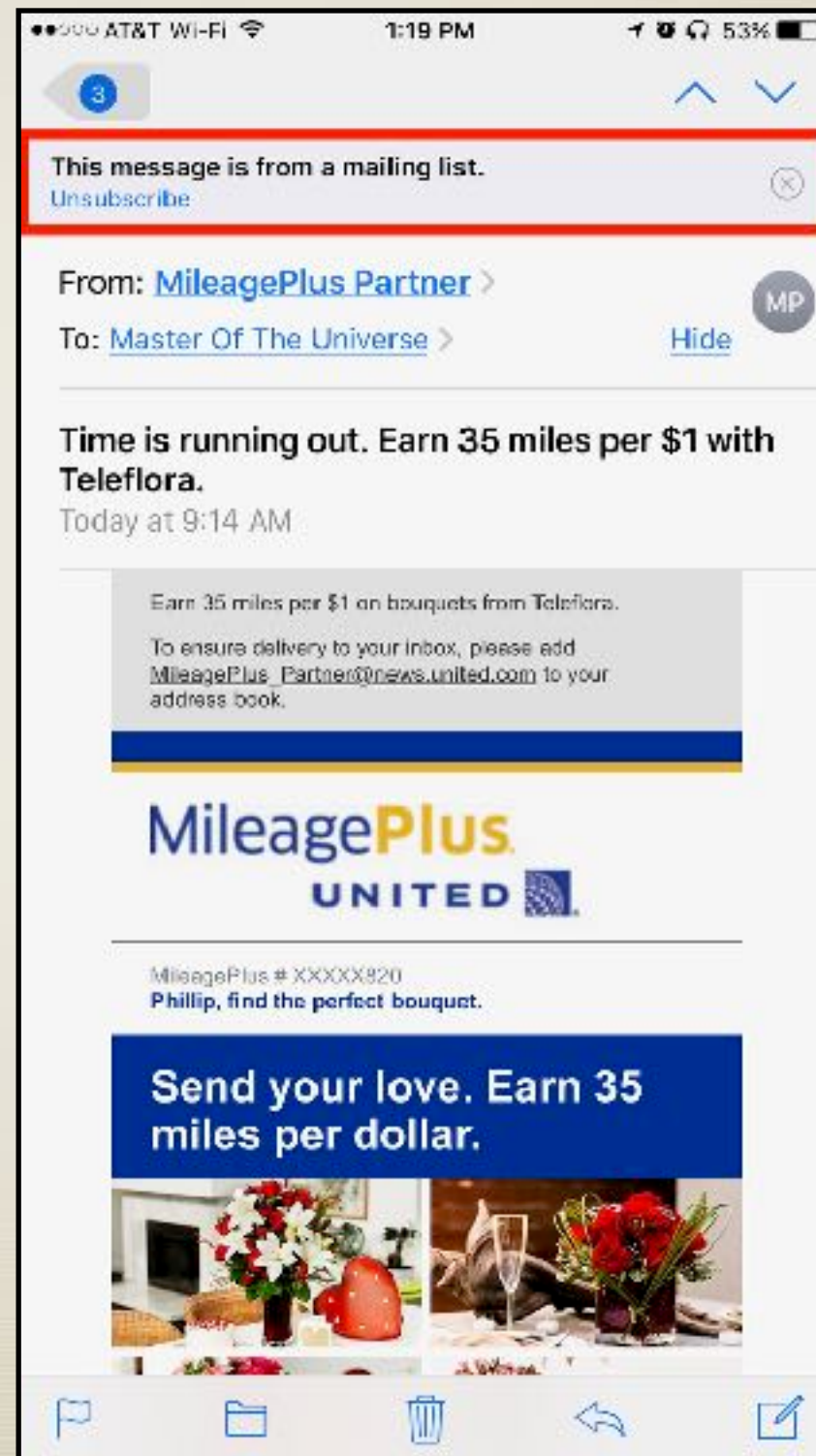

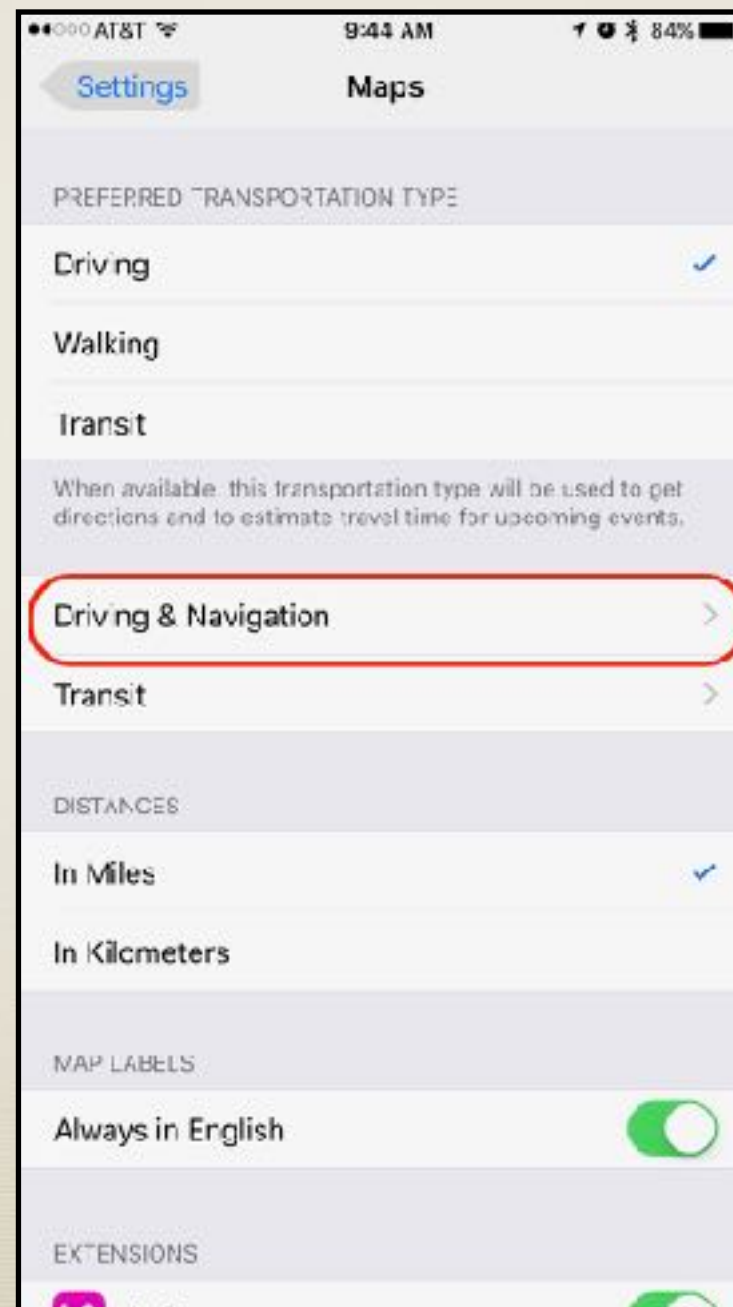


Unsubscribe Mailing Lists

- * If email is recognized as coming from a mailing list
- * Tap Unsubscribe at top of message
- * Easily removes you from the mailing list



Maps - Avoid Tolls or Highways



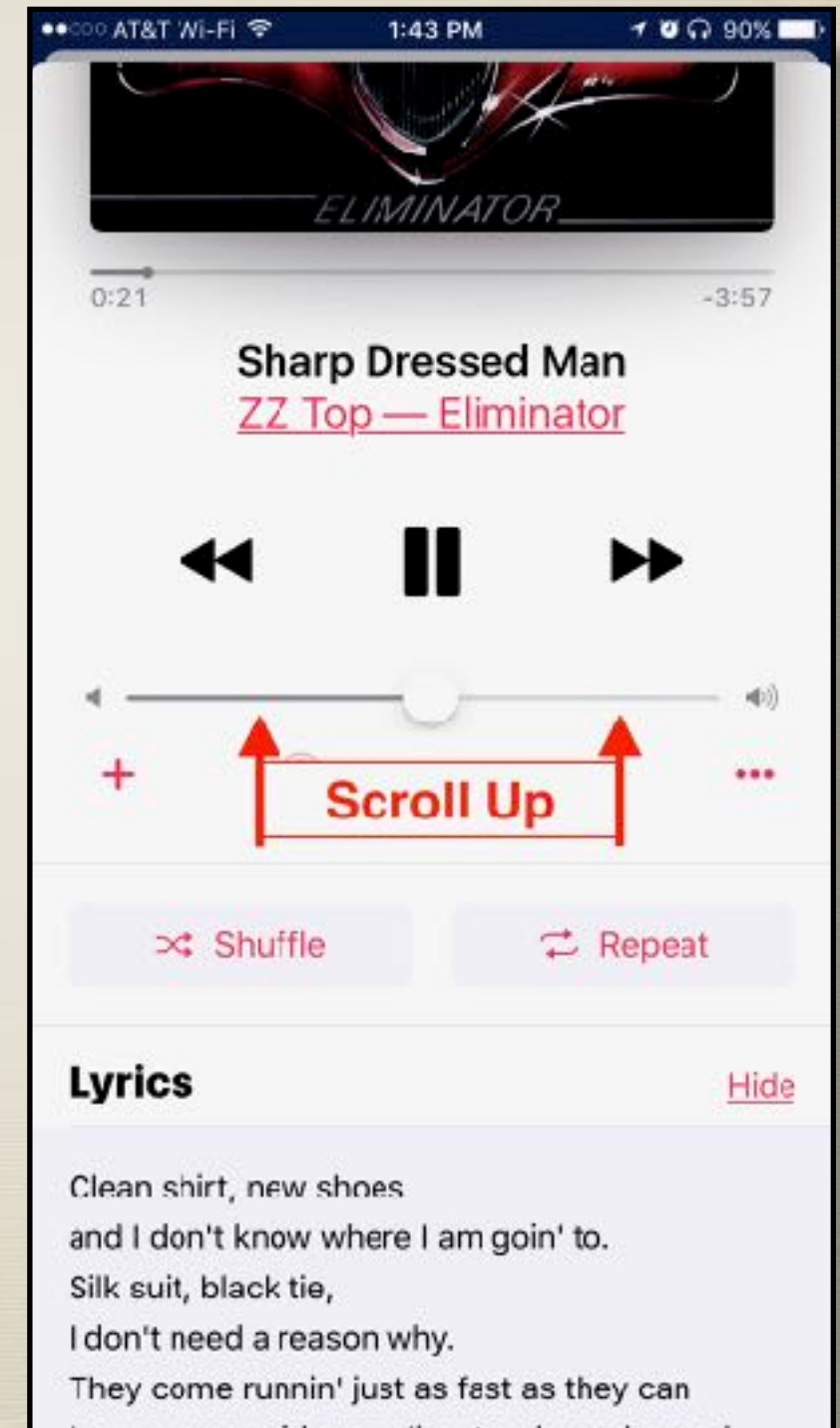
Texting - Automatically Send Full Screen Effects

- * *Happy Birthday*
- * *Congratulations*
- * *Happy New Year*
- * No other words, e.g. 'Congrats Uncle Fred' will not produce screen effects



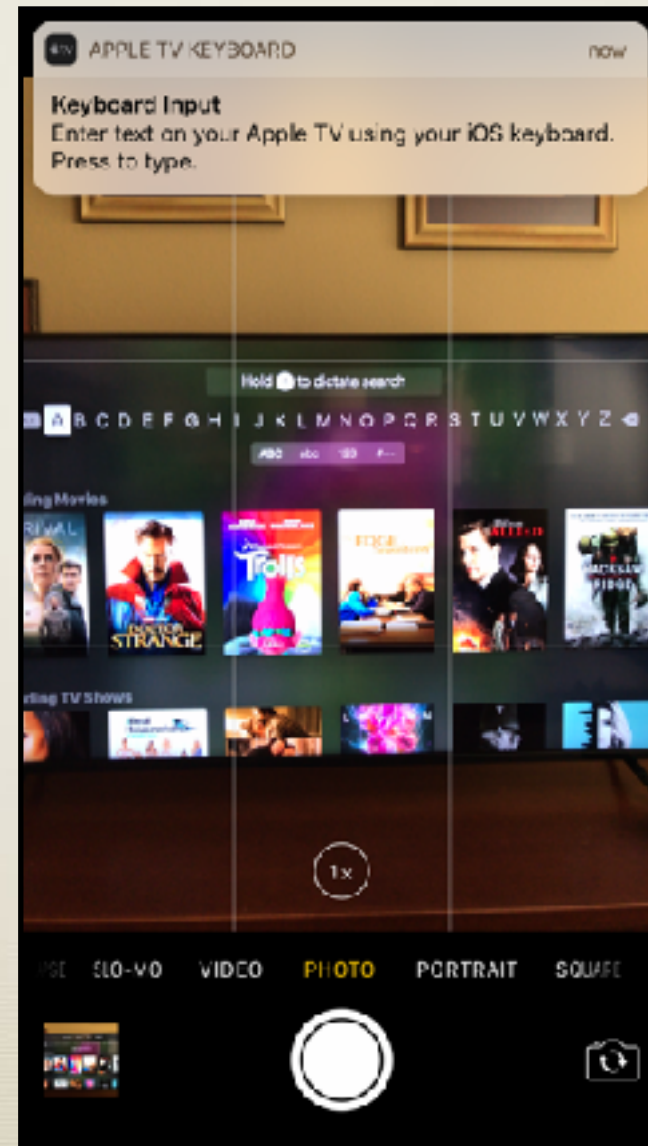
View Lyrics in Apple Music

- * Open Music
- * Play a song
- * Scroll up
- * Not all songs have the lyrics
- * Shuffle and Repeat buttons are here too



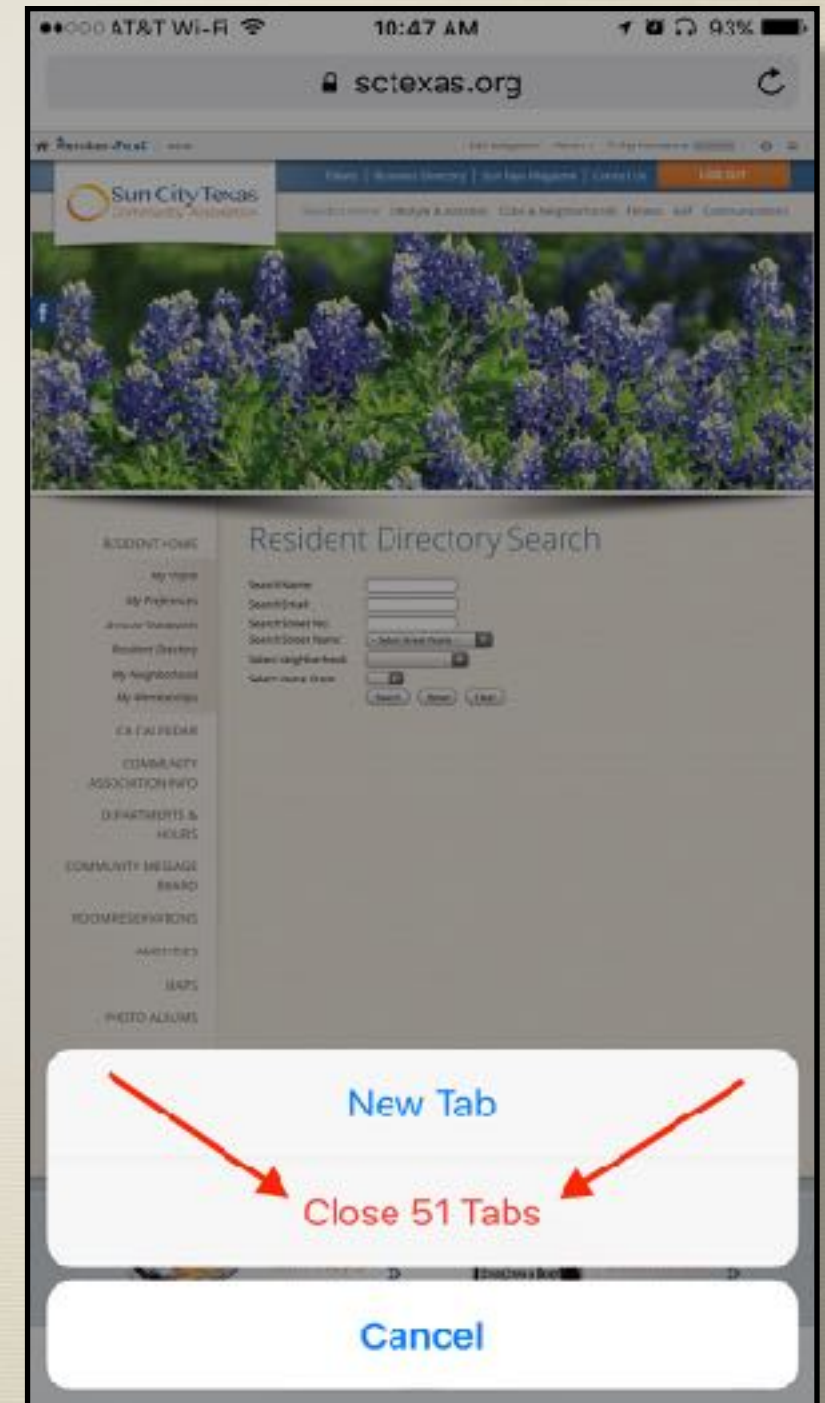
Apple TV Search Input on iPhone

* Alert on iPhone pops up when you select 'Search' on Apple TV



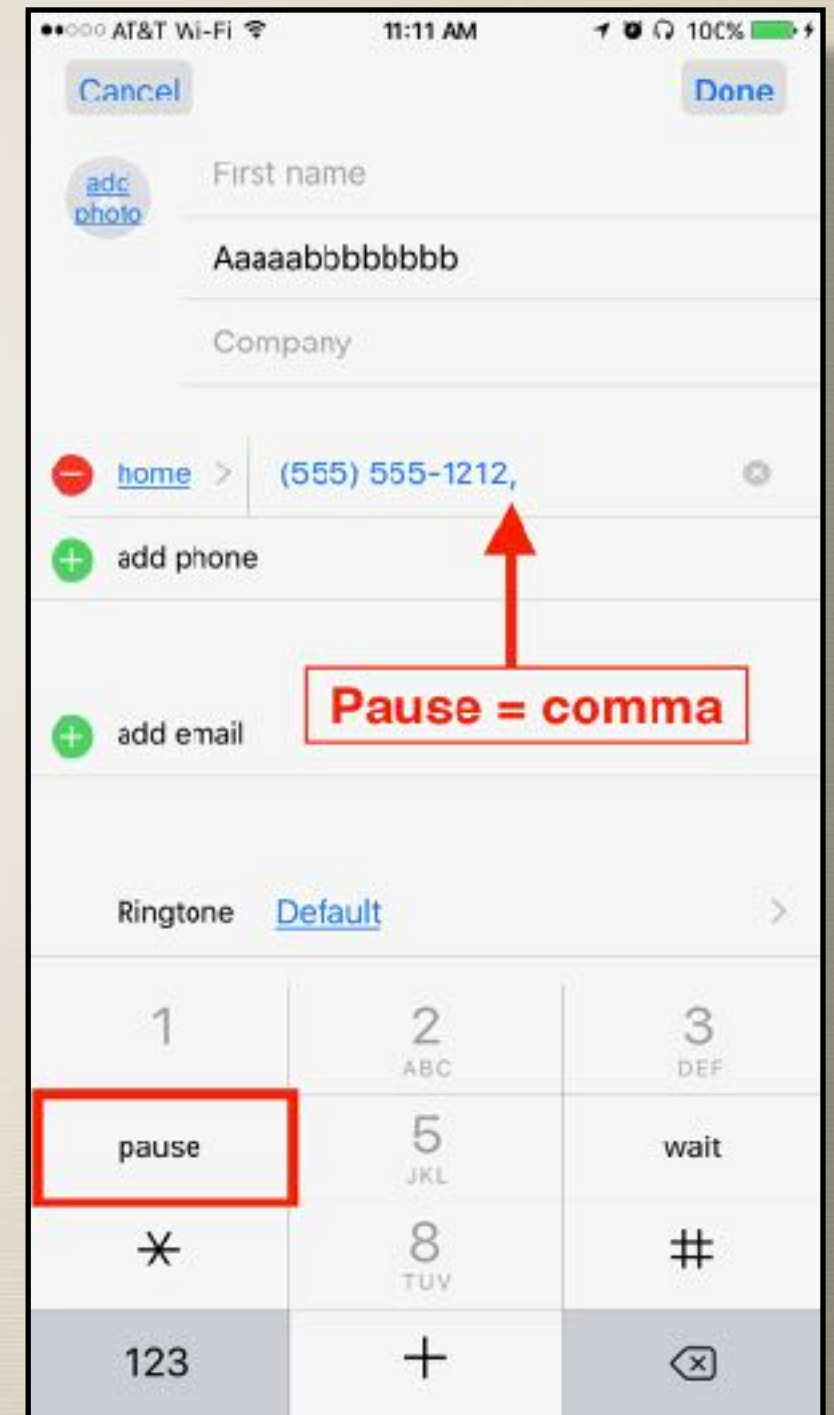
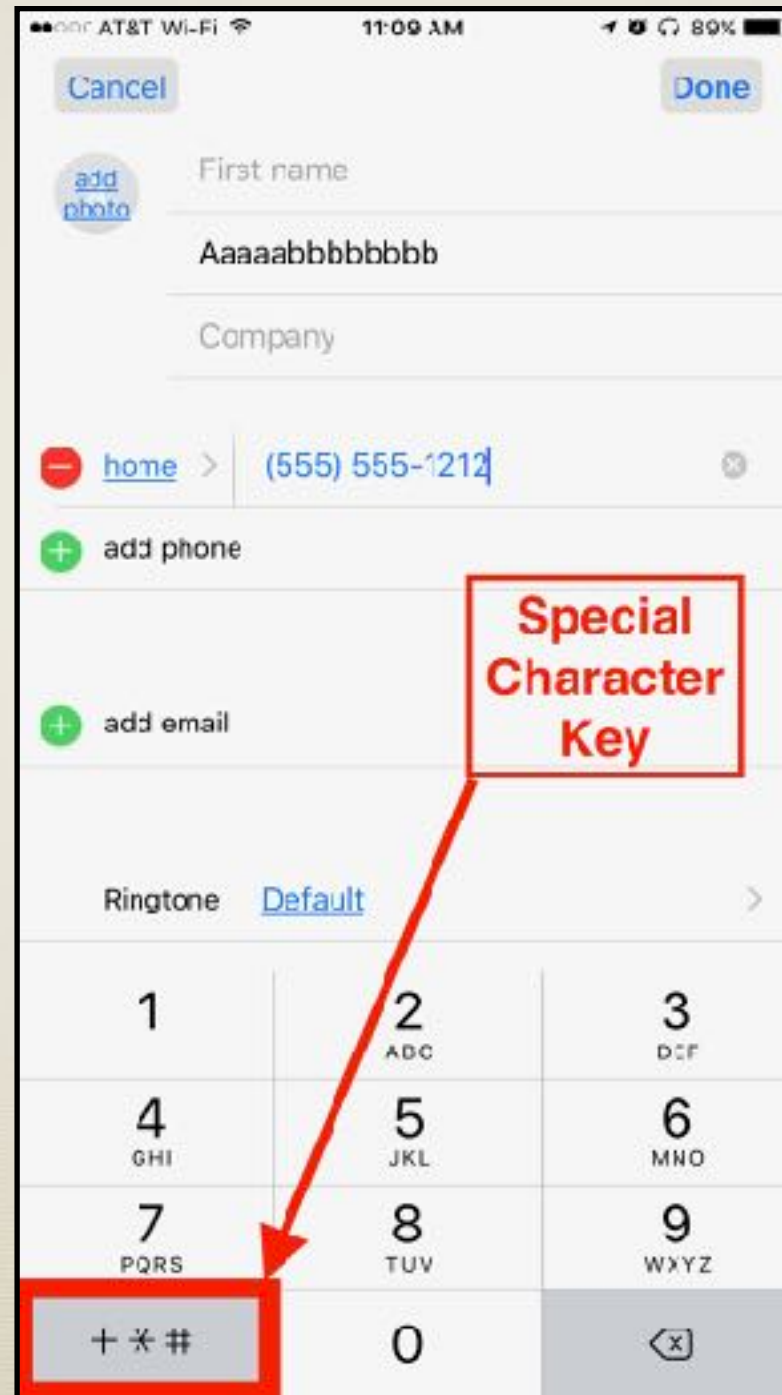
Close all Tabs in Safari

- * iOS 10 allows unlimited Safari tabs
- * Close them all with one tap
- * Hold tab icon
- * Tap 'Close x tabs'



Add Phone Extensions in Contacts

- * Edit a contact
- * Enter phone #
- * Tap special character key
- * Tap Pause button - a comma
- * Enter extension



Use Siri to Search Your Photos

- * Hey Siri - Show me pictures from:
- * Dates: Last Tuesday, Christmas 2016, October 2015
- * Places: Las Vegas, Japan
- * Categories: Cookies, palm trees, sunsets, birds



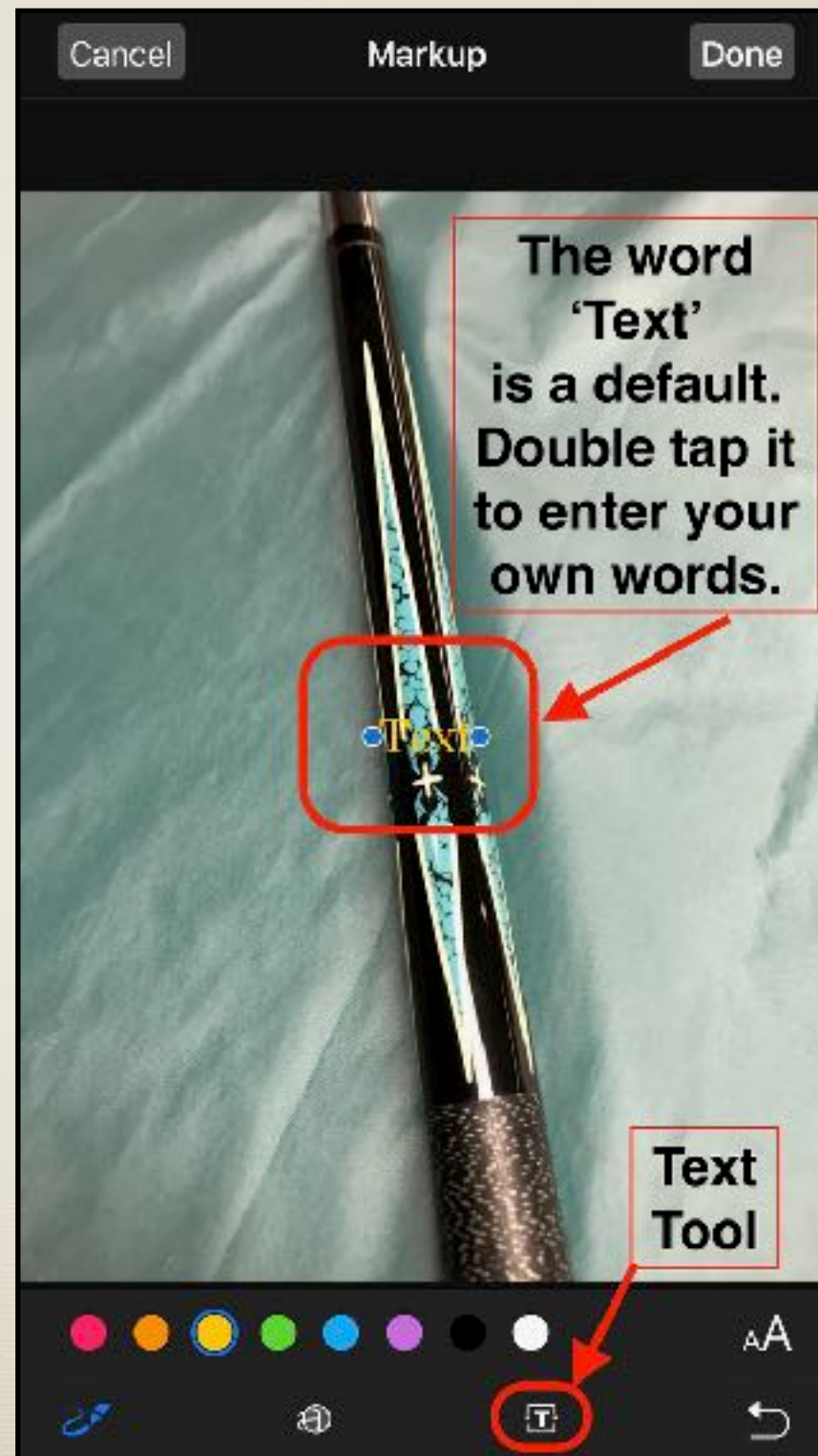
Markup Photos to Add Text

- * Open Photos App
- * Select a photo
- * Tap edit bars
- * Tap 'Hamburger' icon
- * Tap Markup



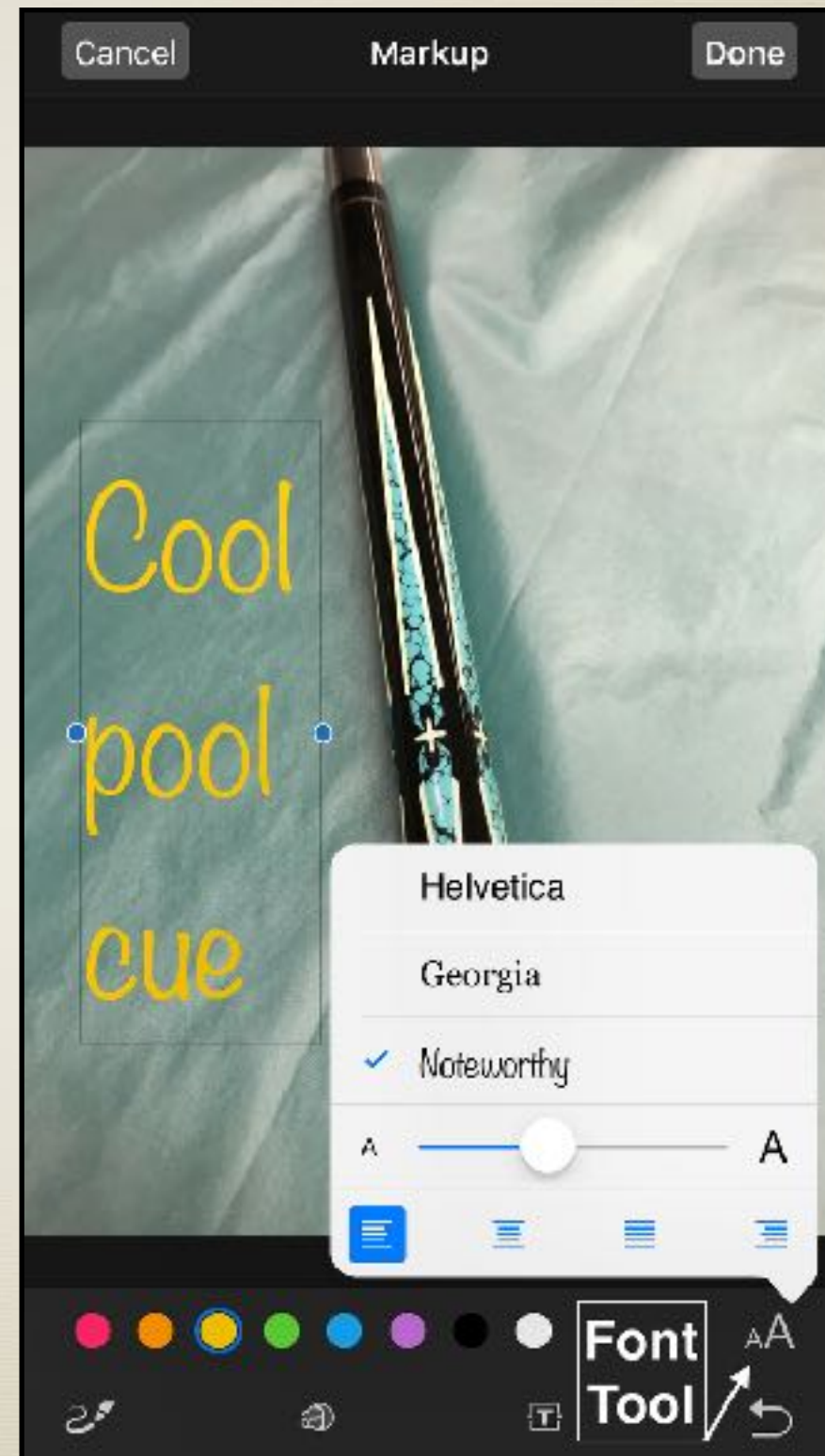
Markup Photos to Add Text

- * Tap Text Tool
- * Double tap text
- * Enter your text
- * Drag text to position
- * Tap Done



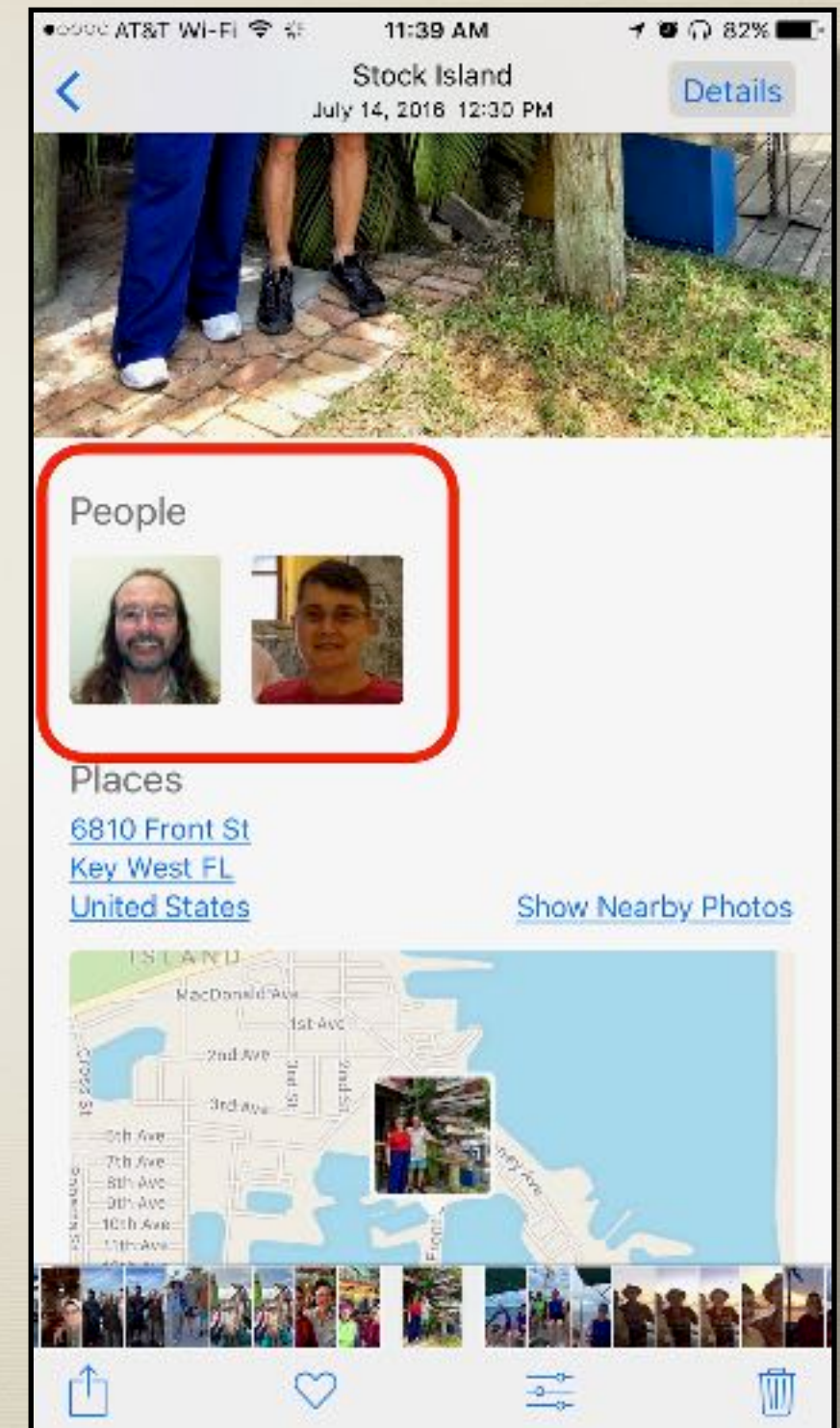
Markup Photos to Add Text

- * Tap Font Tool
- * Adjust size, font, justification
- * Tap Color Dots to change text color



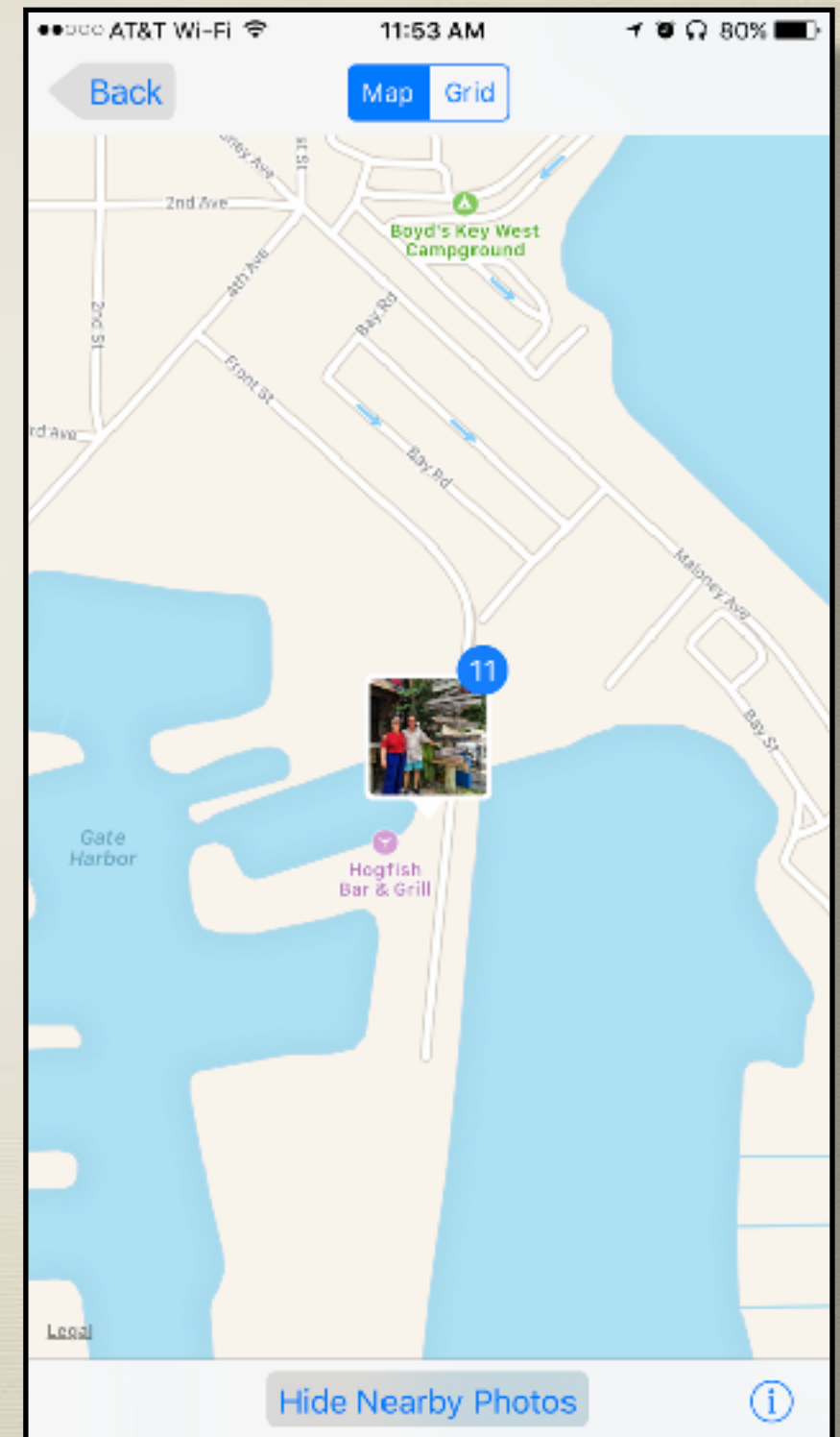
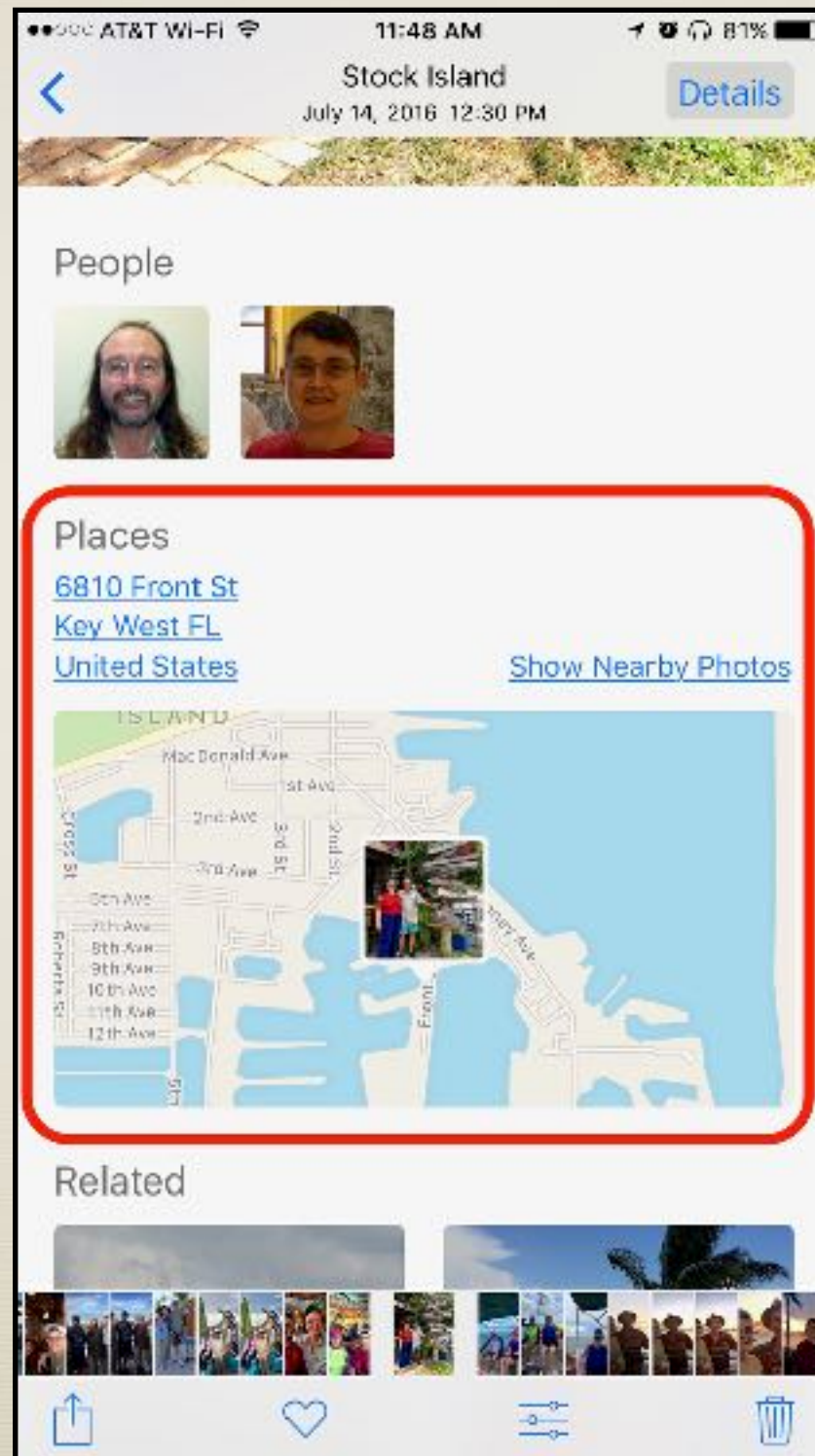
Photos Detail Button

- * Open a photo
- * Tap Details
- * People
- * Facial recognition



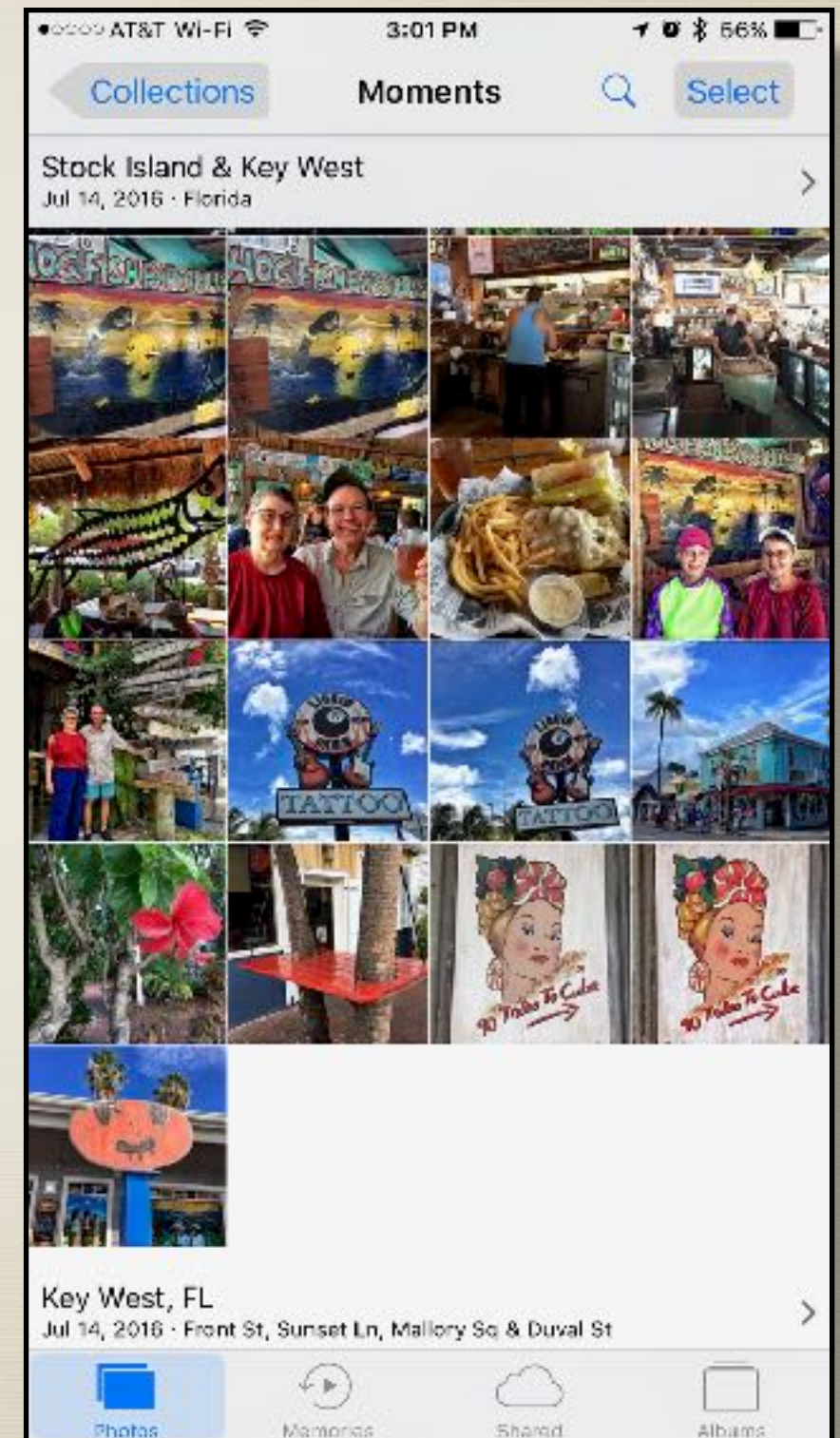
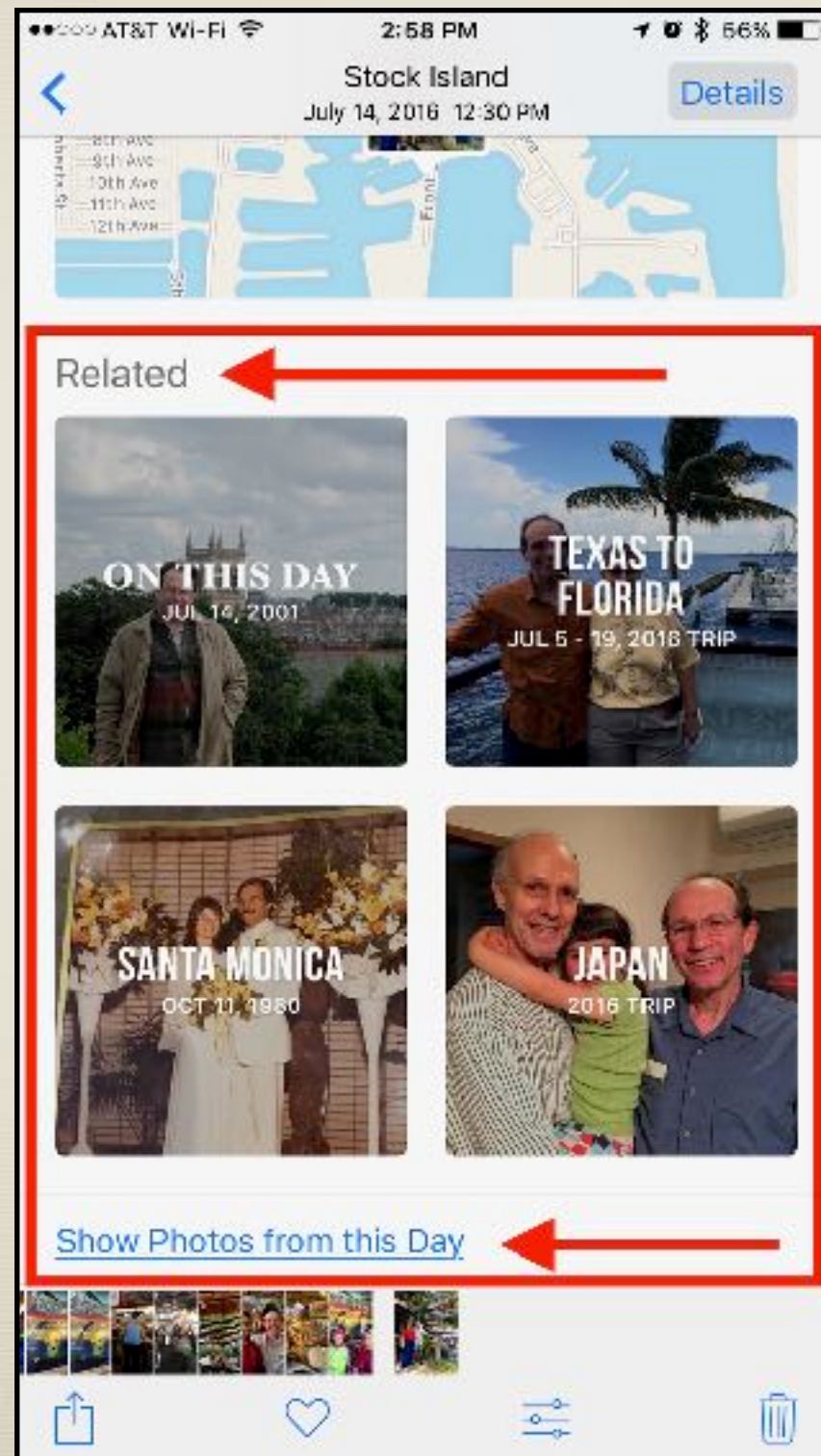
Photos Detail Button

- * Places - map location
- * Show Nearby Photos
- * Pinch Map to see more nearby photos



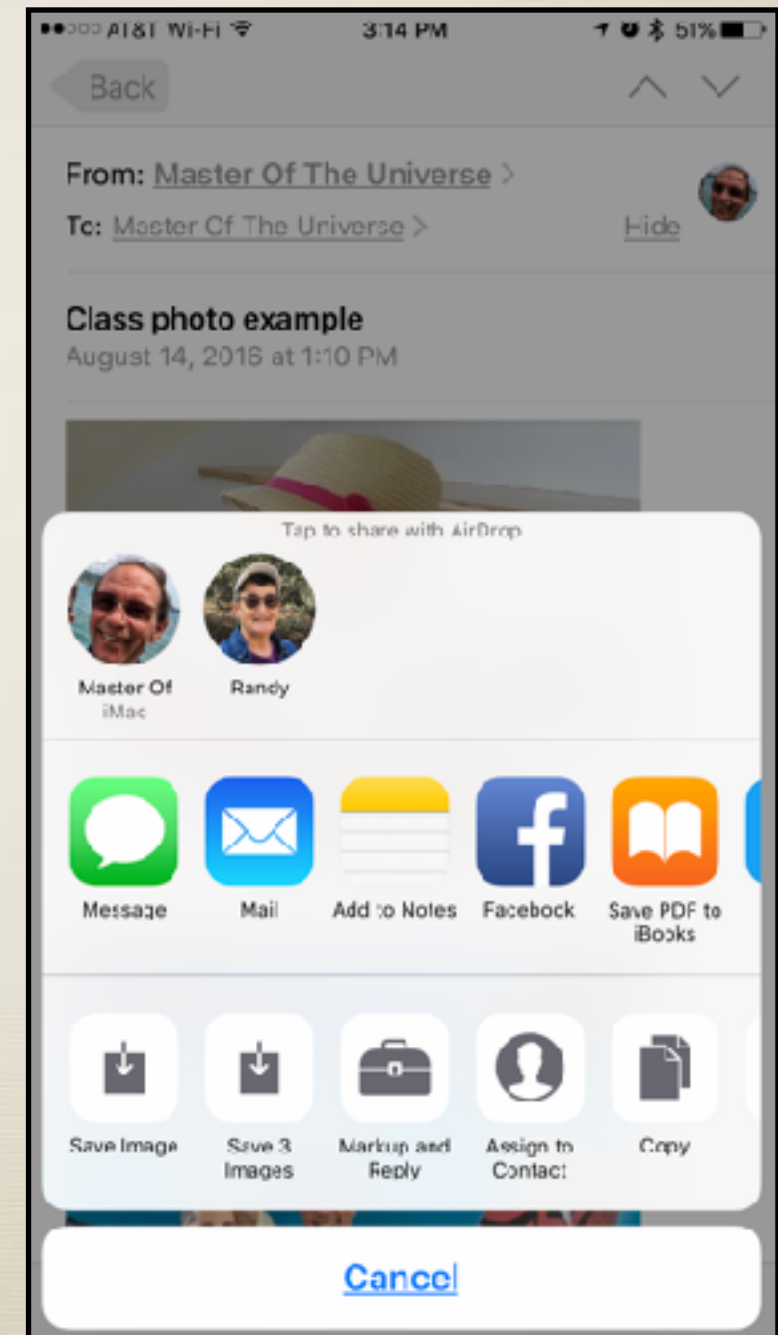
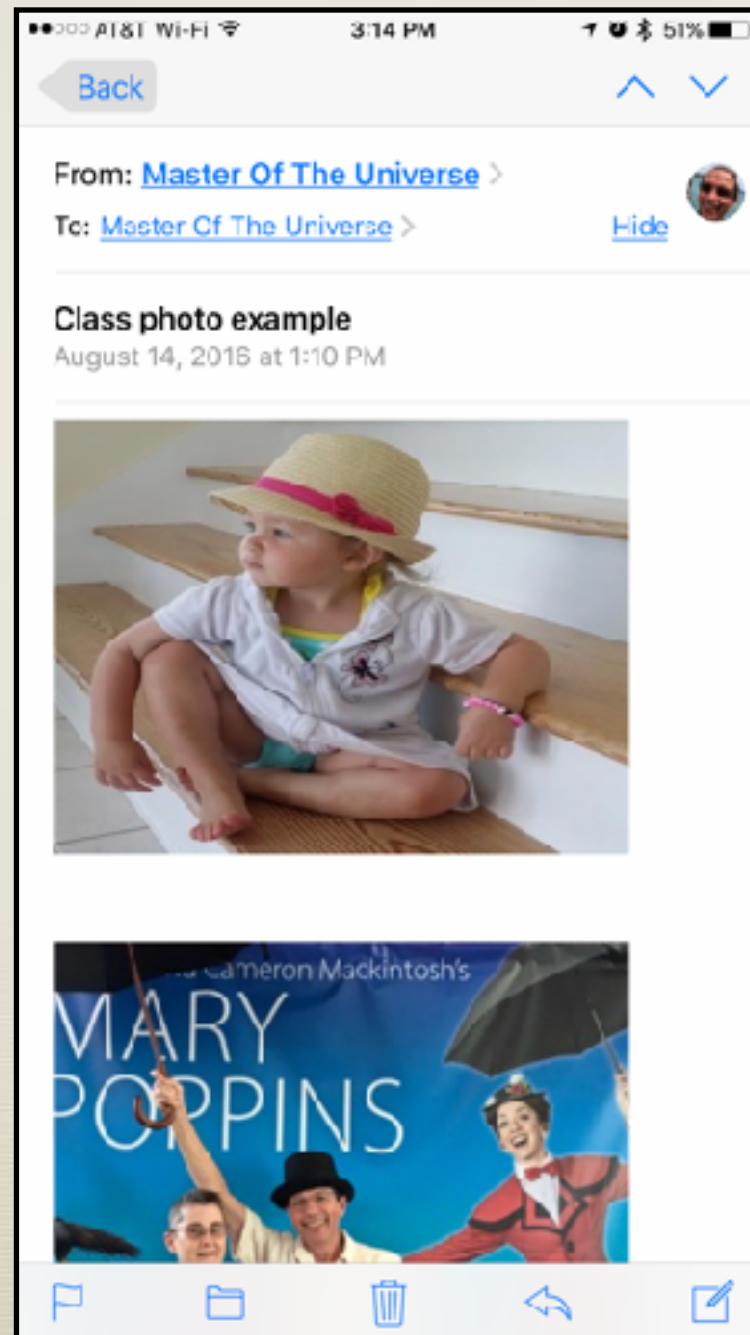
Photos Detail Button

- * Related photos
- * Photos from this day



Save a Picture from Email, Texts or the Web

- * Press and hold image
- * Tap 'Save Image'
- * Saves to Photos App



Wi-Fi Calling & Wi-Fi Calling on iCloud Connected Devices

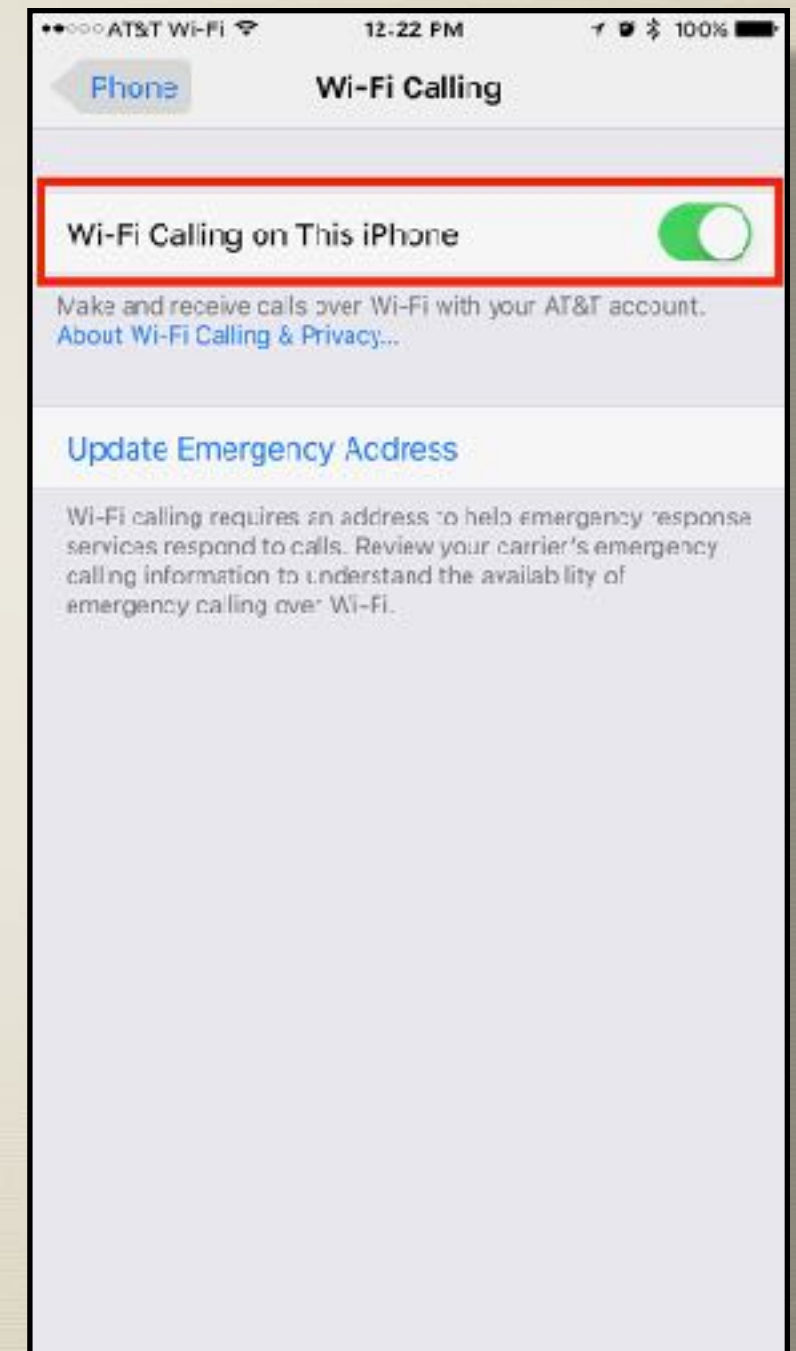


- * Enables phone service over wi-fi in areas with poor cellular reception
- * You must have an iPhone 5S or later
- * Your phone carrier must support it
- * You must be connected to a wi-fi network

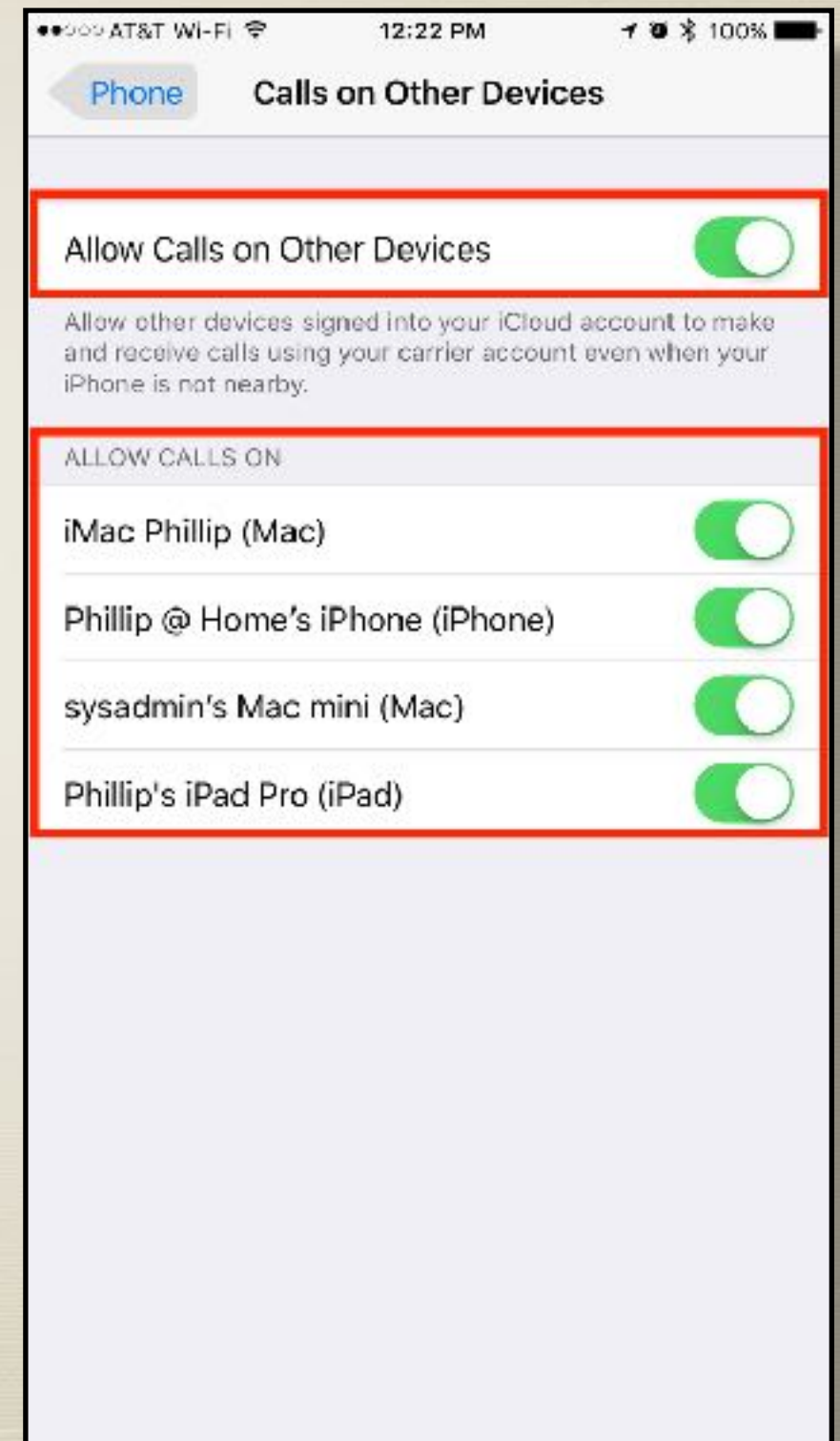

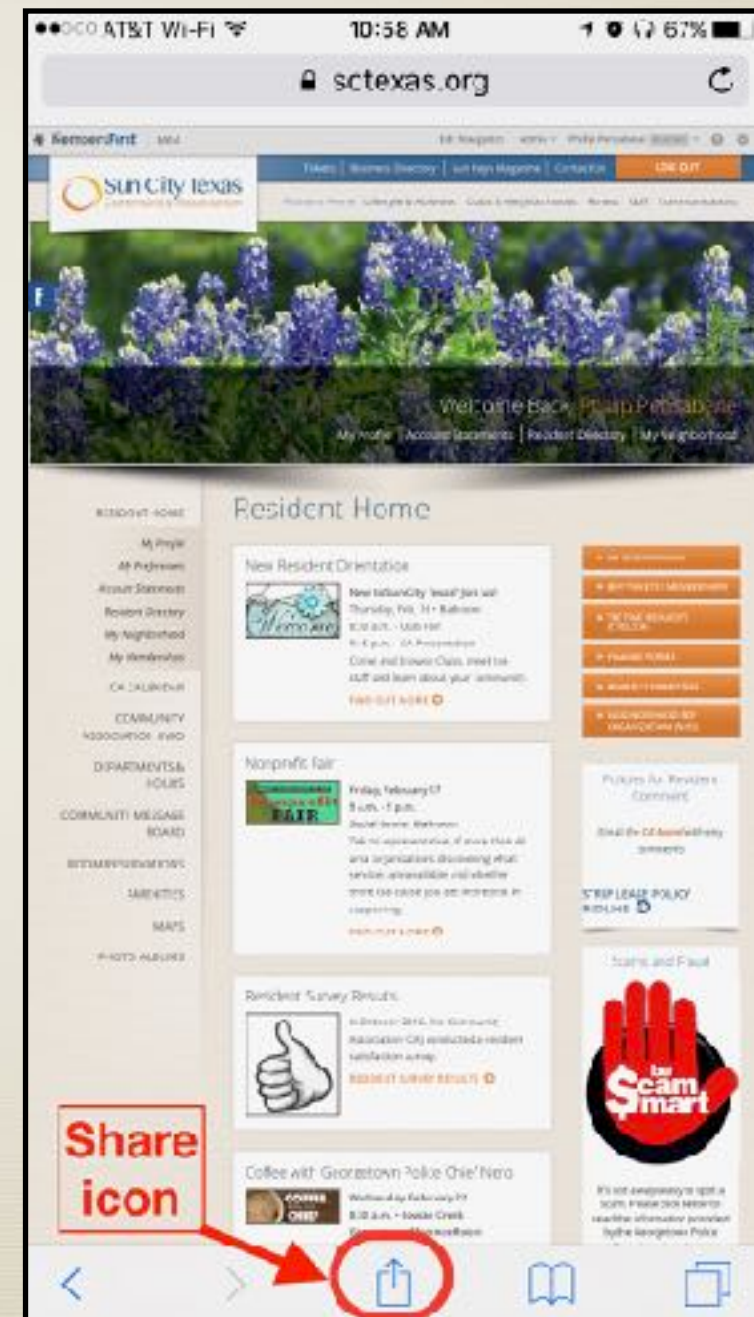
- * Open an email

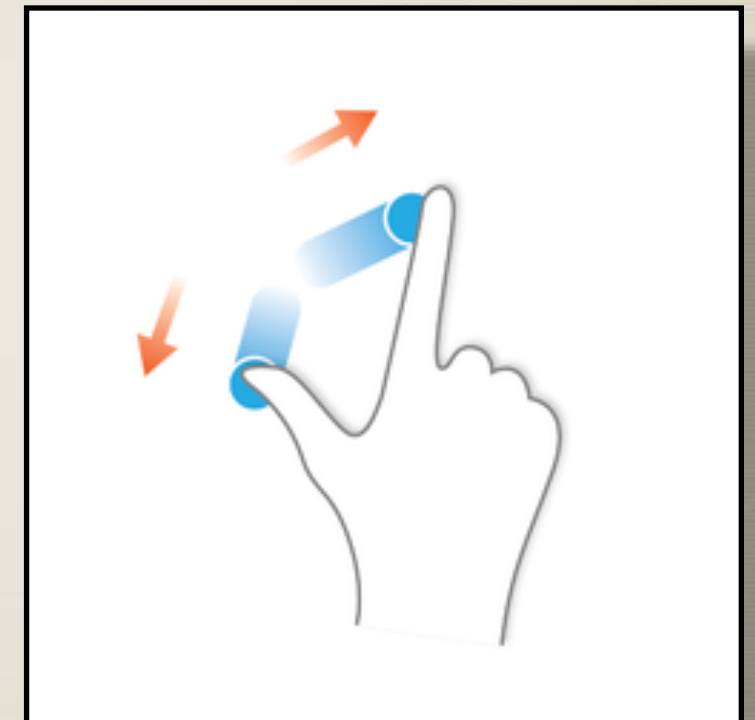
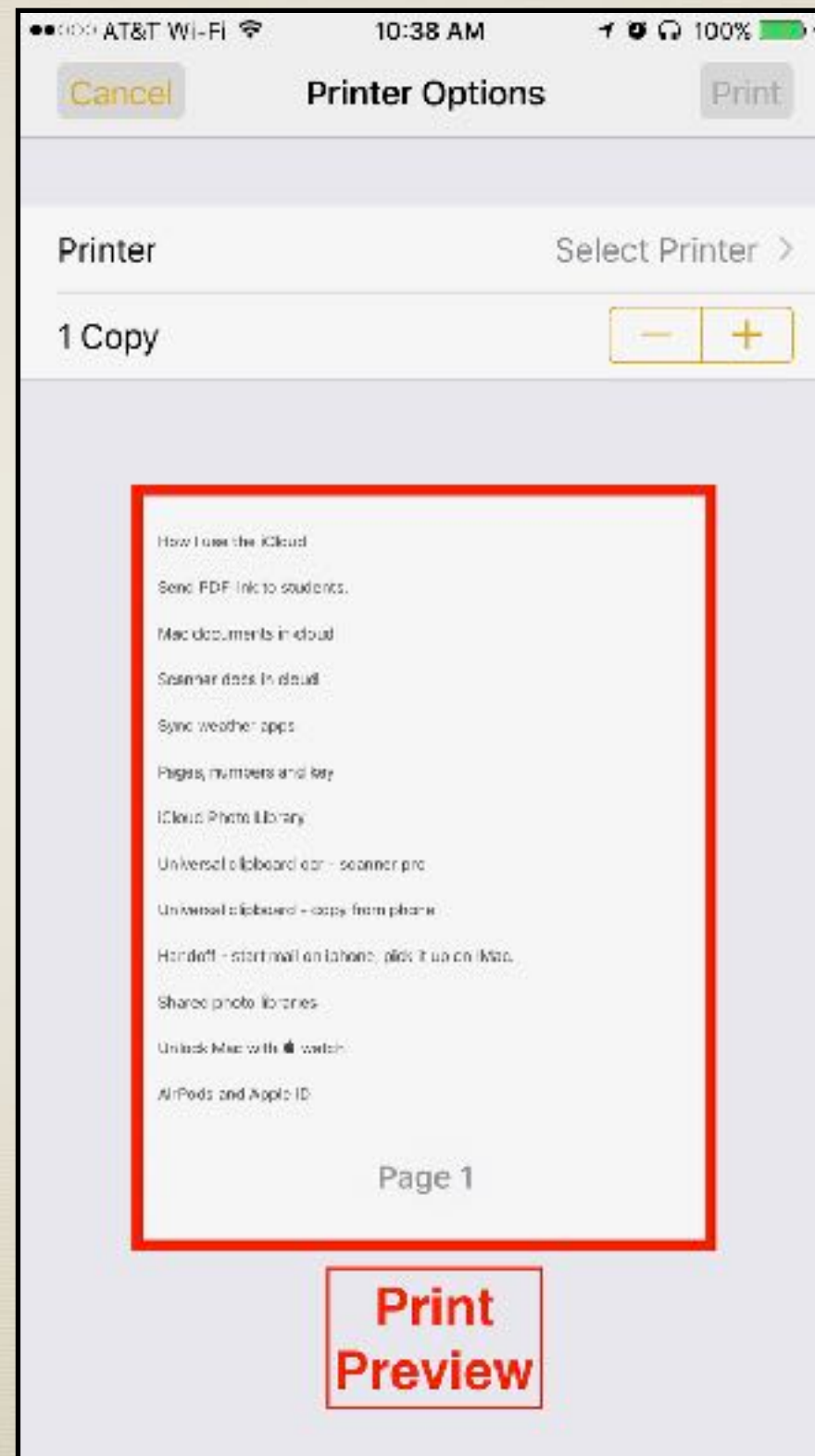
Webpage, Photo or Attachment

Save *Anything to a PDF

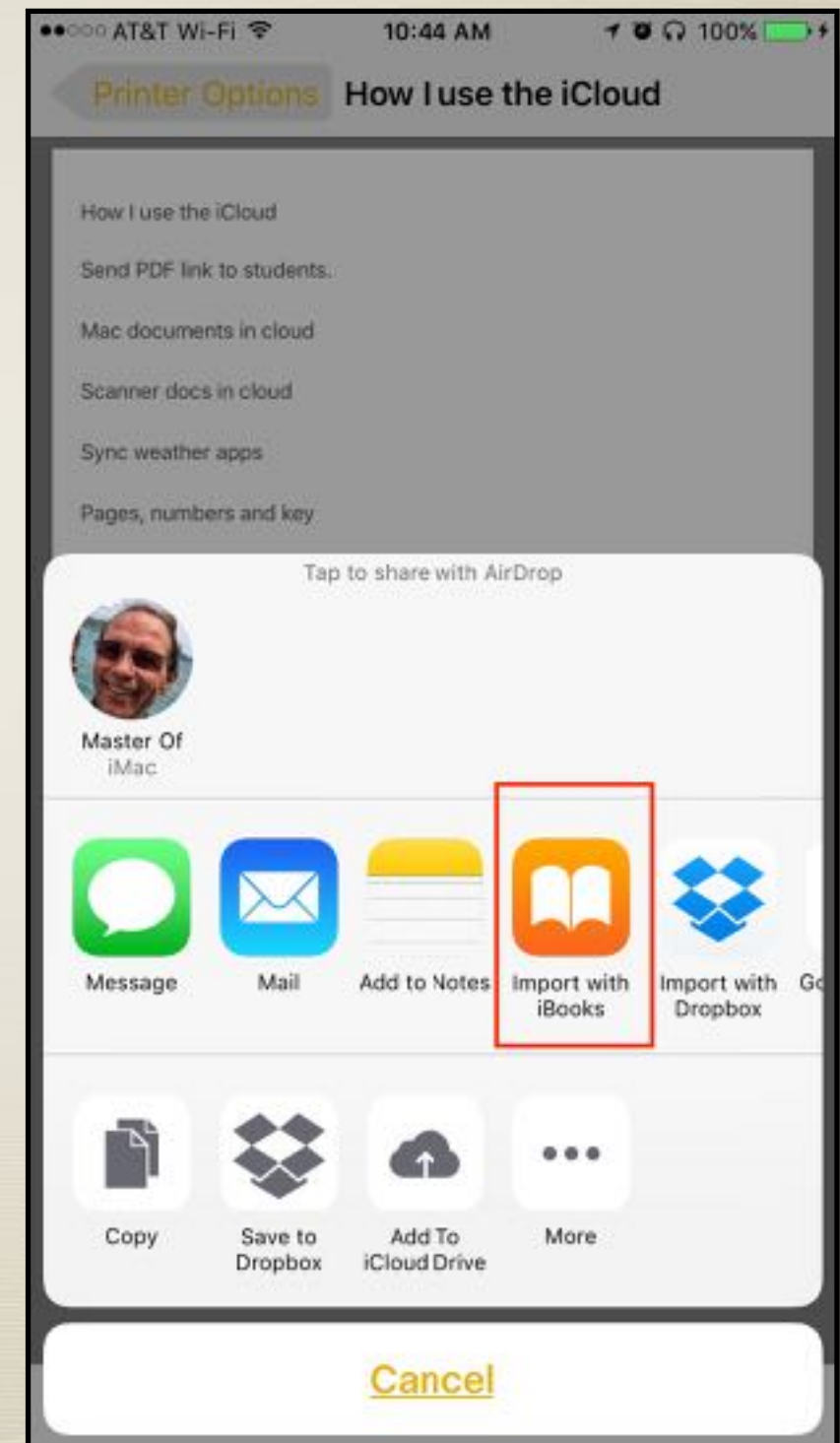
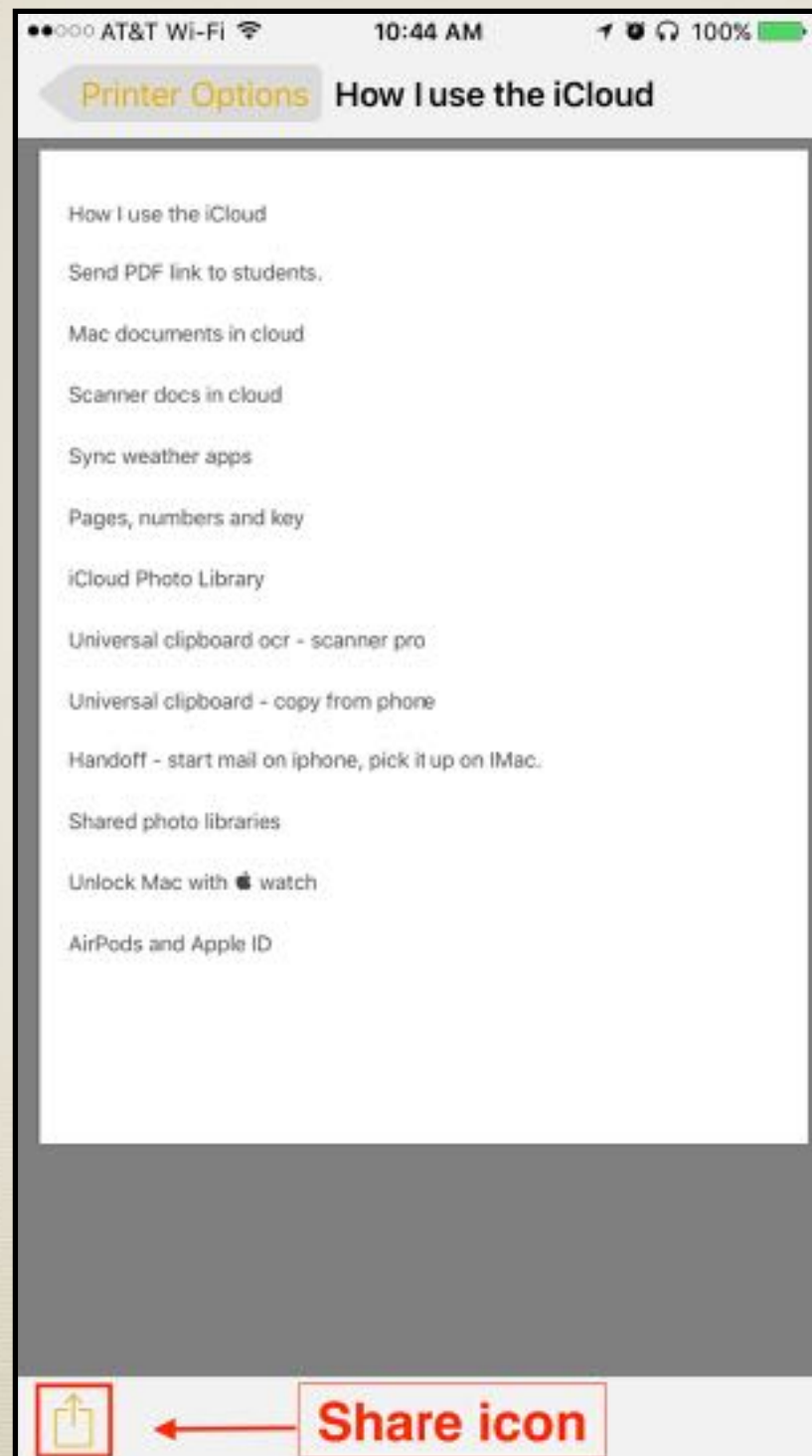
* 'Spread' the print preview

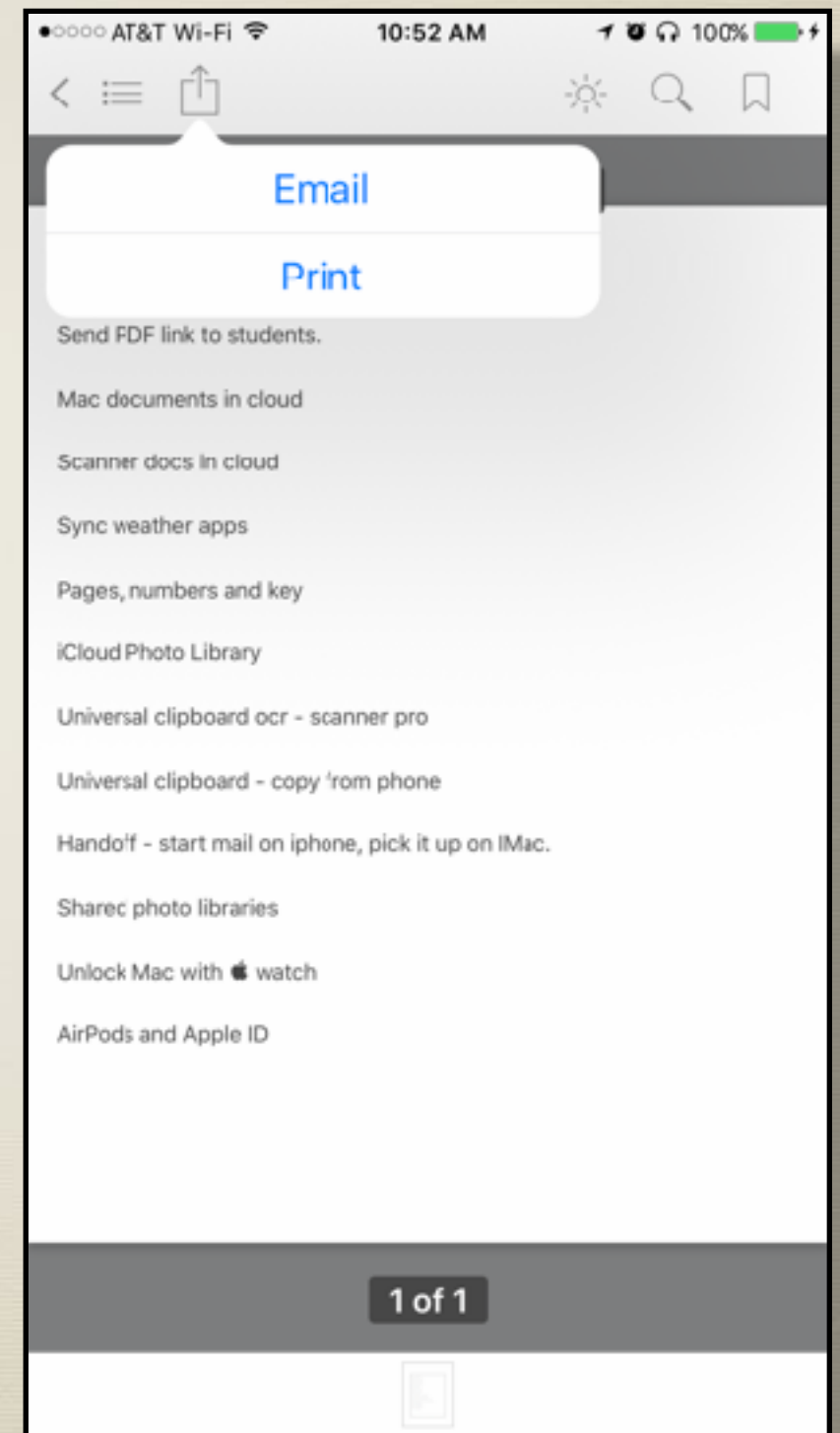
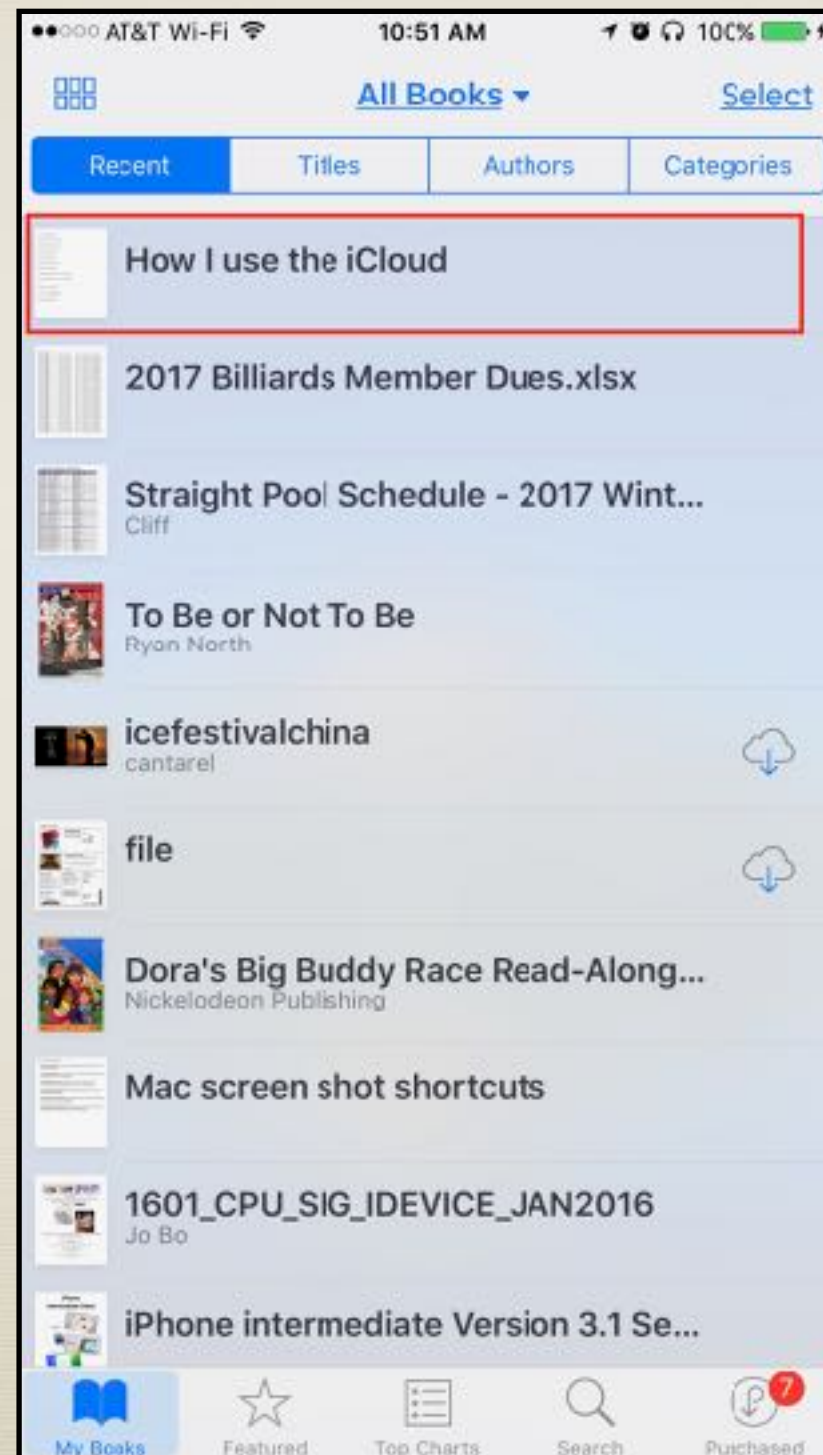
