Malware Alert:

A recent version of the popular computer maintenance program "CCleaner" has been found to contain malware. Here is useful information from our Help Center personnel.

CCleaner – What you need to know:

- The recent compromise of CCleaner affected slightly over 3 million of the more than 100 million covered users
- The users affected were primarily 32 bit versions and/or subscribers to the cloud version of CCleaner
- Users should ensure that they employ version 5.34 or higher
- You can download the newest version at this link: http://www.piriform.com/ccleaner/download/standard
- To ensure that malware is removed, run both Malwarebytes and Microsoft Defender
