

Emergency SOS

- Press/hold power and volume buttons
 or -
- 5 Clicks on power button
- Brings up Emergency SOS slider
- Always enabled, cannot turn off
- Auto Call option dials 911 immediately
- Countdown Sound
 - Warning tone and chance to cancel



Press and keep holding the side button and either volume button to make an emergency call.

Also Works with 5 Clicks



When this is on, you can also use Emergency SOS by rapidly clicking the side button five times.



Countdown Sound




Play a warning sound while Emergency SOS is counting down to call emergency services.

The New iPad Dock

- Many similarities to the Mac dock
- It is an app launcher with some superpowers
- Can be summoned from within an app
 - Swipe up from bezel at the bottom of screen -or-
 - ₩\D (command, option, D) from connected keyboard



The Big New iPad Dock

- iPad in iOS 10 had limit of 6 apps in dock
- You can add up to fifteen apps/folders to the dock
- Plus 3 spots for recently used apps
 - Displays Handoff icon from iPhone or Mac



Swiping the iPad Dock

- 'Swipe up' previously activated the Control Center
- Now, a short 'swipe up' opens the Dock
- A longer 'swipe up' opens three things a once:
 - Dock
 - Control Center
 - App Switcher




iPad Keyboard Flick

- No need to shift for numbers or symbols
- Drag down or flick the key
- Must still use shift key for upper case letters




iPad Keyboard Flick


Flick any key with 2 symbols to get the upper one



Files App

- Replaces iCloud Drive app from iOS 10
- Similar to 'Finder' on Macs
- Access your docs and files:
 - On your device
 - In iCloud
 - Third Party app Dropbox, Onedrive, Google Drive









Files App

- Drag and drop between locations
- Share files via text, email, airdrop
- Collaborate by adding people to a file



iPad Drag & Drop



My Customized Control Center




Core group - no edits




- Optional group






Document Scanner

- New feature added to Notes App
- Open a note, tap Plus sign, tap 'Scan Document'
- Options color, greyscale, B&W, Photo
- Options Auto-shutter or Manual-shutter
- Prompts for multi-page scans
- Optional save scan to Photos or Files app




'Plus Sign Button'

Apple Maps Lane Assist

- Lane guidance on freeways and major roads
- Especially helpful if you are unfamiliar with the route
- Turn by turn voice commands match the graphics
 - e.g. 'Stay in the middle two lanes'

Lane Assist & Speed Limit




Do Not Disturb While Driving


- Detects when you are driving
 - Automatically by motion or -
 - When connected to car bluetooth or -
 - Manually enable
- Suppresses most calls and notifications

Do Not Disturb While Driving

- Emergency alerts, timers and alarms break through
- Incoming calls are allowed...
 - Only when connected to handsfree accessory
- Siri is voice response only no screen display
- Configure options in settings


Do Not Disturb While Driving





Siri Translate

- Ask Siri to translate:
 - Mandarin, Spanish, French, German and Italian
 - 'How do you say where is the post office in Italian'
 - Response by voice and on screen
 - Play button allows you to repeat voice






- Two new features




Live Photo Effects

 - Swipe photo up to reveal effect options







Loop Bounce Long Exposure








Family Sharing iCloud Data


- One family member must be using at least the 200 GB plan
- Up to 5 additional persons can be added to the plan
- Each persons photos, videos, and data remain separate
- Settings > your profile > Family Sharing





- Your new iPhone just arrived?

Automatic Setup



Share Wi-Fi Password

- Want to let a friend join your home network?
- Have them open settings > wi-fi
- Bring your iPhone or iPad next to their device
 - Also works from Mac with High Sierra
- Tap on the push notification on your phone
- The password automatically fills in on their phone

Camera does QR Codes

- Open the camera
- Point at the code
- Link will appear
- Tap to follow link





'People' Photo Album

- If you use the iCloud Photo Library then:
- People you name will sync across all your devices
 - Open Photos App
 - Tap Albums Tab
 - Tap 'People' album
- Named people are now searchable in Photos
 - 'Hey Siri' show me pictures of Dad

- Send money to friends
- Requires:
 - Apple Pay
 - Receiver uses iMessage
