The Sun City Bocce Club participated in the 11th Annual Yountville Invitational Bocce Tournament in Yountville, California. Only 16 teams across the U.S. are invited to participate each year.

All money raised from tournament entry fees, silent auctions and raffle tickets goes to the Veterans Home of California at Yountville. This VA hospital is home to approximately 1,200 war veterans. This year's funds go to supporting returning vets who suffer from PTSD.

Besides competing in the tournament for about nine hours on Saturday, the team enjoyed the sights and gastronomical delights in the area.

"We had a wine and cheese gathering at the Friday night practice and a fantastic dinner at Don Giovanni restaurant in Napa," Mr. Mellinger said. "Saturday morning we started the day with a continental breakfast, lunch was a catered barbecued chicken with water, draft beer and wine all day.
