- New Products on the way?
 - Trio of new iPads
 - Face ID on iPad Pros?
 - New iPad Pro 10.5 inch with slim bezels
 - Updated Pro 12.9 inch model
 - Lower priced 9.7 inch model (no Face ID)
 - No new Mini in sight (7.9 inch)
 - Lower price MacBook Air?
 - \$799-\$899 (currently \$999)
 - Lower Price on existing HomePod
 - (currently \$349)
 - New lower priced version of HomePod
 - Maybe \$150
- Timeframe?
 - Maybe June for WWDC
 - (World Wide Developers Conference)

Phishing e-mails, phony support calls and other scams

- **Protect your Apple ID password**
 - Remember your Apple ID password too!
- **Use two-factor authentication**
- **Change your password if you think it is compromised**



Be Extra Cautious When Browsing the Web

- **Browsing the web you may see pop-ups alerts or ads warning you of problems with your device/computer.**
- **They are designed to trick you into calling a phony support number or buying an app to fix the problem.**
- **Don't call the number, don't buy the app**
- **Navigate away from the page or close the window or tab.**
- **Close Safari.**
- **Open multitasking and dismiss Safari**
 - **Double click home button on iPhone 8 and older**
 - **Swipe up and right for iPhone X**
- **Settings>Safari>Clear History and Website data**


- **If you think you need to check your account or change a password, never do it from a link in an email.**
- **Go to the site in Safari and log on directly**




- Ask Callers to Hold

The good:

Looks great

Sounds great

Easy set up

Plug in and bring iPhone close

Apple Music integration

Stream any source via Airplay

Homekit integration (e.g smart lights)

Great voice recognition

Far Field Microphone

The bad:

Expensive - \$349

No Stereo pairing (yet)

No auxiliary ports

No direct support for 3rd party streaming

e.g. Pandora, Spotify, iHeart Radio

No multi-voice recognition

Does not play if no wi-fi is available

e.g. Doesn't play directly from bluetooth

Can only be controlled by Apple devices

In the middle:

Siri - mostly good, but not always
