# Analysis of Suddenlink Billing 

Ways to reduce your bill

## History

- Analyzed 40+ statements submitted
- Contacted Suddenlink via phone
- Multiple visits to Suddenlink store
- Phone calls to other providers


## Summary of Results

- Suddenlink pricing and billing are, to put it kindly, are almost unintelligible
- It's almost impossible to figure out all of the charges and their billing department can't explain all of them
- There is no actual price list available and you are not told about options that could save you money unless you ask the right questions


## Analysis of My Bill

## What I Changed

- I already own my modem; otherwise I'd be paying an extra \$10+tax each month
- Returned the two SL HD DigitalLink devices
- Changed to a plan that allows me to download 250 gigabytes per month ... if I go over this, I'm charged $\$ 15$ each for additional 50 gigabyte amounts ... I've only been over 250 once
- My new total bill is $\$ 161.22$, a savings of $\$ 39.97$ each month

## Internet Speeds \& Pricing

| Speed in Mbps | First year price | After one year | If you own modem |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| 100 | 40 | 60 | 50 |
| 200 | 50 | 70 | 60 |
| 400 | 60 | 80 | 70 |

First year price is for new customers only and includes the modem. After one year the price goes up $\$ 10$ for modem rental and $\$ 10$ for Internet. For all of these there is an additional $\$ 5$ or so of taxes. You can save the $\$ 10$ modem rental by buying your own.

They also offer 1 Gbps service but I didn't ask the price. There is also a slower less expensive service for users who make little use of the Internet but I didn't get the pricing for that either.

If you have 50 Mbps Internet - and many do - they will change it to 100 Mbps if you just call 1-844-227-1627 and ask for it! This is also the number to call about making other changes or you can go into the office and talk to them.

## Modem Cost

- These modems will work for you and save you money. These are only modems, not combination modem/routers. Many others will work as well.

Netgear CM400 (343 Mbps) \$ 51.41
Netgear CM500 (686 Mbps) \$58.91
Netgear CM500V (686 Mbps) \$126.99
(with phone jack)

## Options for Telephone Service

- Frontier Communications (was Verizon)
\$45 per month with 7 Mbps Internet service for first two years; after that they could not say what the price would be and they could not tell me what the taxes/fees would be. My neighbor has this service, gets only 2.5 Mbps and pays a little over $\$ 90$ per month.


## Suddenlink Telephone Service

- Phone $\$ 10 / m o n t h$
- $100 \mathrm{Mbps} \$ 40 / m o n t h$
- Taxes \& Fees approximately \$5/month
- Price increases $\$ 10$ after one year
- ... For a total of about $\$ 65 /$ month
