Nominations for 2019 Computer Club Board:

According to the Bylaws of the Sun City Computer Club, following the October Board meeting the Communications Director will send a communication to members informing them:

- a. of the appointment of a Nominating Committee including the committee members' names;
- b. that the Nominating Committee will be seeking nominees for all Board positions until the first Monday in November [November 5];
- c. that written nominations from the members will be accepted by the Nominating Committee from the date of this communication until the first Monday in November:
 - (1) that a member may nominate him/herself by submitting to the Nominating Committee a dated and signed statement giving his/her own name and position seeking; and
 - (2) that a member(s) may nominate another member with that member's approval by submitting to the Nominating Committee a dated statement signed by the nominator and the nominee giving the name of the nominator, the name of the nominee, and the position for which the nominee is being nominated; and
- d. that If there is more than one nominee for a position, all nominees will be listed on the ballot.

The Nominating Committee members are Jim Hackett, Chair, Paul Hensley, and Jan Renfro. If you wish to nominate yourself or another

At these sessions, attendees will be encouraged to bring their own computer equipment (desktop, laptop, or tablet) to the event to work one-on-one with an instructor and have their
