I then began playing with the "real" bocce players.


Folks, you just have no idea until you come by the courts and play with these "players", all with years of experience and comradery unequaled.

New Procedure For Groups to Share the Courts

New rules for groups using the courts designed to share the courts and give everyone a chance for group play

Now your group can reserve the bocce courts for two-hour blocks. To reserve the courts, use the form shown at the right, It is available on the Bocce Club Website.

Court times will change to take advantage of the seasonal weather and daylight.
Earlier times in Jan and Feb for instance, later times during March to October.

Two-hour time slots are shown on the reservation sheet. Please use the time slots as indicated. They have proven to provide good play with considerations to both sun and shade.

The time periods allow us to fill the needs of residents, clubs, groups and members.

For groups with long term reservations, they must be renewed each quarter. You will need to request your courts each Quarter as follows:

MARCH 15th for April, May and June.

JUNE 15th for July, August and
September.

<u>SEPTEMBER 15th</u> for October, November and December.

<u>DECEMBER 15TH</u> for January, February and March.

The Bocce courts can be reserved in 2-hour time slots which will change according to seasonal weather and daylight. Please refer to the time slots at the bottom of this reservation form when requesting your court reservations as these are the times available. This will allow us to fill the needs of our club and community events. If you have a long-term reservation you will need to request your courts each quarter as follows: on the 15th of MARCH for April, May and June. JUNE 15th for July, August and September. SEPTEMBER 15th for October, November and December. DECEMBER 15TH for January, February and March.
