

2019 BOCCE CLUB MEMBER SURVEY

Forty surveys have been received from the Bocce Club Membership. About 20% of the members completed the survey. At the time of the survey we had approximately 200 members; we are now close to 300 members. The survey summary is available on the Bocce Club website.

The board greatly appreciates the responses and is listening to the members. A key issue for members concerned what set of rules would be played at Sun City, below is the result from the survey:

Based on the result, both Sun City Rules and International Rules will be played in the leagues and tournaments. The league or tournament organizer will be responsible for establishing which format will be used. For tournaments with outside clubs, either here or there, International Rules will be played.

Sixty-five percent (65%) of survey respondents indicated that they participated in the open play and nearly 70% play more than 9 times per month. The board feels these are very positive and hope to grow these numbers.

The overwhelming positive comments were that Bocce Club is fun, easy to learn and courts are always available. Comments on desired changes were less focused, but all survey comments will be reviewed and considered by the board.
