## **Book Group**



He soon discovers that someone has been systematically destroying every copy of every book Carax has written. His seemingly innocent quest opens a door into one of Barcelona's darkest secrets-a story of murder, madness, and doomed love.

We will meet on Oct. 22, 1:30pm, to discuss the book *Lilac Girls* by Martha Hall Kelly.

Summary: Taking place during WWII, it tells the story of three young women: a young socialite working at the French consulate, a Polish teenager working for the underground resistance movement and a young German doctor. The three lives become intertwined when the young resistance worker is sent to Ravensbruck concentration camp.




