



How do we really hear?

• Sound, what is it? How does it travel, how do I hear?





How do we hear? Our Brain!! Your brain perception is unique to you!



my friend has hearing aids and he/she struggles, why?

- Many different reasons:
 - Extent of damage to our cochlea, how long did a person wait before receiving help?
 - WRS low word recognition score auditory deprivation
 - LDL/UL sensitivity to loudness
- Problems with auditory processing and cognitive function
- Prescription Hearing aids will not bring you instant gratification.

They are not like eyeglasses More like skates – buy a good pair, a good coach and practice

Success MAY COME WITH Detours / slowdowns

- Problems with auditory processing and cognitive function, which can result in difficulty focusing, remembering or processing information they have heard
- Dexterity issues
- Not wearing all day everyday
- Fighting the "tinny" or mechanical sounds
- Lack of communication
- Hearing aids can't bring hearing back to normal
- Hearing aids can't make your low WRS significantly better. Tricks to help this.

What can hearing aids do?

- New technology– Millions of \$\$ spent
 - SNR speech noise ratio
 - Automatic identifying
- Binaural Directionality coordinates between both ears, seek out speech over background
- Spatial Sense Ability to recognize and transform sound frequencies
- Noise Tracker Noise has been identified- compressed within miliseconds
- Sound Shaping Strategy for improving high Frequency audibility.
- Mobile phone apps more precisely control your environment

Cont. What hearing aids can do

- Bluetooth connectivity phone calls can be answered using both ears and all phones
- GeoTag saves your favorite locations
- T-Coil Very important for many users
- Find my hearing aid
- Remote programming
- Multi Mics / Roger or others like this
- TV Streamers
- Rechargeability up to 30 hours run time after every charge, no more battery changing

Levels of Hearing devices and oTC options Manufactures have different levels and costs

- Economy \$1,200 \$1,999 OTC, Costco 40Db maximum output allowed by FDA
 - "adults age 18 and older to compensate for perceived mild to moderate hearing i mpairment."
- Basic \$3,999 \$4,200 Stay at home, not social, small intimate groups no background noise
- Mid \$4,800 \$5,700 Semi-active, car, shopping, small meetings, small-medium groups
- Best \$5,800 and up Active lifestyle, conventions, large gatherings, music, large meetings
 - FYI Higher cost to my client doesn't mean more money for me!
