




Photographer of the Month November 2019 Ken Johnston

This is a judged Print Competition, with ribbon awards going to First, Second, and Third Place in each of nine categories. Honorable Mention ribbons will also be awarded. There will be a "Best in Show" and a "People's Choice" award.

Acceptance of submissions is based on the order of entry. The first 120 entries will be accepted. Notifications of acceptance will be sent by November 2, 2019. Photos will be received from 9 to 11 a.m. on November 9, 2019. Judging and hanging will occur later that day.


Union Pacific has restored to operation a Big Boy, the largest steam engine ever built. They last ran in 1959. The engine is touring the US and will be in Texas in early November.



Tickets for the bus are being offered exclusively to members of the SC Photography Club until October 31st, after which they will be offered to all residents of Sun City. You will be able to visit camp sites for both the north and south, see men on horseback, see a military wedding and a fashion show as well as visit the plantation home. 
