A few words from Ron Pontiff - President

The Bocce Club has started early this year, with a calendar full of events. Two hundred and fourteen (214) members have taken advantage of the \$1.00 discount by signing up last December. We encourage the rest of the members to sign up soon, the one-month grace period ended January 31st and if you have not renewed, your name will be dropped from distribution lists. Our calendar is filling up and we don't want you missing any of the fun events.

The Bocce Website now uses only one calendar to display court scheduling and all other Bocce planned activities. See the calendar for these exciting events:

- Eight neighborhoods have games during the year.
- Twenty-two social events are planned throughout the year
- A full year of training has been scheduled. The format for the training sessions has changed. The first day will be an introduction to bocce for all Sun City Residents, the remaining two sessions are enhanced training for Bocce Club Members, only.
- In addition to the Legacy Open Play, 6 days a week, the club offers other opportunities for open play including: Open Play for Beginners, Couples Fun Group, the Polar Bear League and Ladies Open Play.
- The Board has now begun having monthly meetings.

New for 2020:

- The Rules of Play and League Regulations have been revised and re-posted on the Website. The revisions were minor, and they were revised at membership request.
- The Bocce Club Bylaws revisions are in work. These revisions will be routed to the membership for approval. Primary need for the revisions is to reflect changes in CA policy and to permit Special Interest Groups (SIG's).

The Bocce Club has two new SIG's:

- Pure Bocce Special Interest Group allows for International Play in an open play environment. On-line registration on the Bocce Website is available for those who wish to join.
- The Bocce Lifestyle Special Interest Group will link Bocce club members to the cultural, culinary, and creative endeavors that are so much of the Italian lifestyle. They will offer learning experiences in Italian cooking which will also provide Italian dishes for club social gatherings. They organize meals at area Italian restaurants for groups of club members to learn new Italian dishes. Travels further afield may follow. The SIG's first big event, Lifestyle Festival is on April 19. If you are interested in joining this fun group or would like more information, contact Dick Billows.

Revised Court Request Forms can now be used to schedule events for the entire year. Remember, events scheduled with these forms should use bocce balls in the plastic bin on the side of the shed.

The 2020 League play started early and enthusiastically. We currently have 3 leagues:

- Advanced Sun City rules (Monday 1 pm)
- Advanced International rules (Friday 1 pm)
- Intermediate International rules (Tuesday 1 pm).
- All leagues have 16 members and the Club will record scores for each player and maintain the scores throughout the year.
- Players must play a minimum of 24 games (8 days) to be eligible for end of year play.

We believe if we had additional league coordinators, we could start new leagues like: Pairs league, Additional Intermediate leagues and a New Player league. Please reach out if you're interested in coordinating a league or being a cocoordinator.

Another innovative idea for league play is a "drop-in league" The concept is similar to an open play group but with scoring. I would like to schedule this concept on Saturdays at 1 pm. Any member of the club could "drop-in", play 3 games and

we'll maintain your scores throughout the year. The advantages to a drop-in league are no registration, no commitment to a 5-week league and still maintain scores through the year.

New ideas for Tournament play are hosting outside Bocce clubs like Kissing Tree or Del Webb Frisco.

The Sun City Bocce Club plans to reinstate the Neighborhood Challenge Tournament this year. More details will be provided as we finalize the tournament.

Thursday Evening Couples Fun League.

Since we don't have sufficient sun to play bocce on Thursday evenings this group meets at 5:30 at The Retreat patio fire pit instead. It's an enjoyable gathering with snacks, drinks and socializing. Once we get back to daylight savings time bocce players will resume. Look for that announcement in March.
