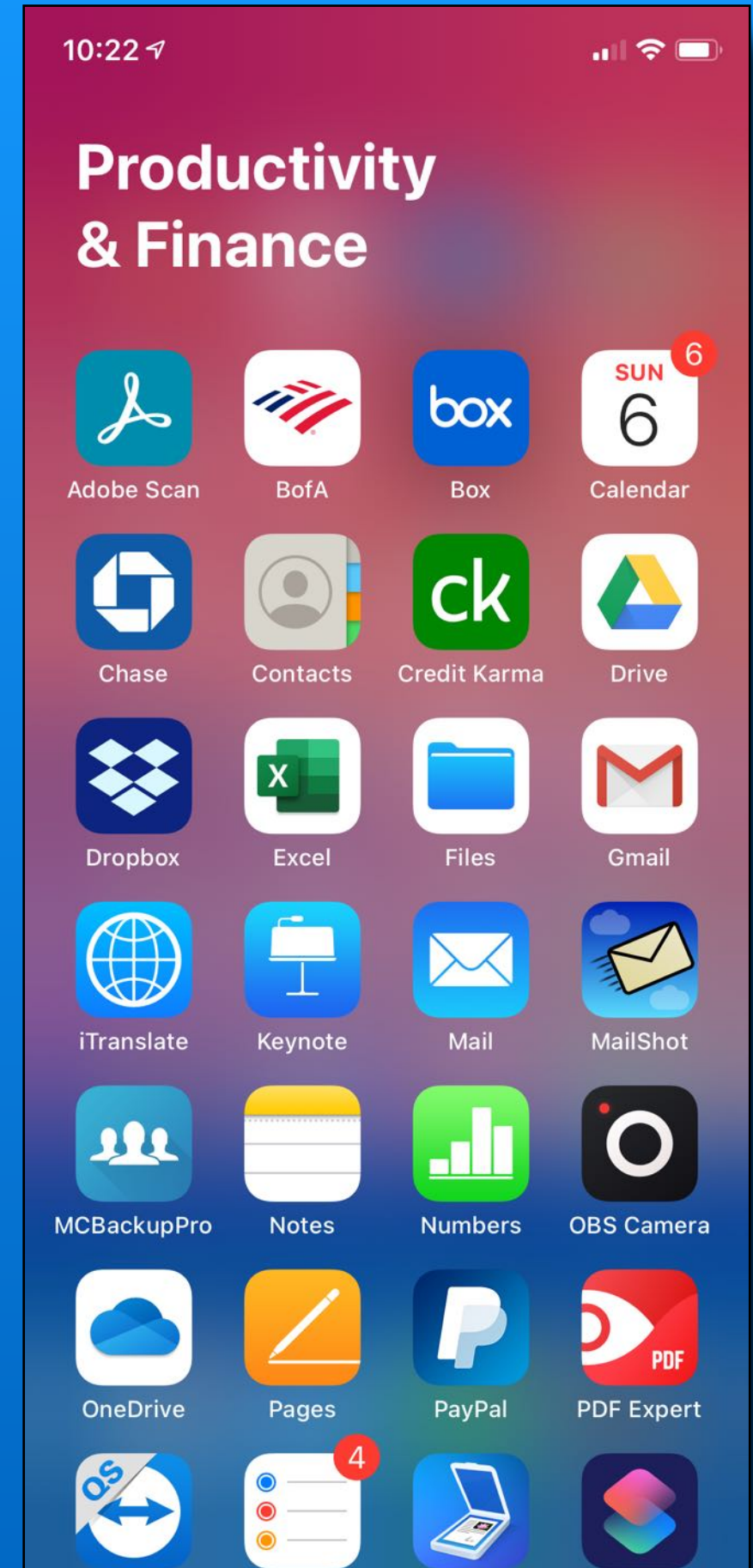

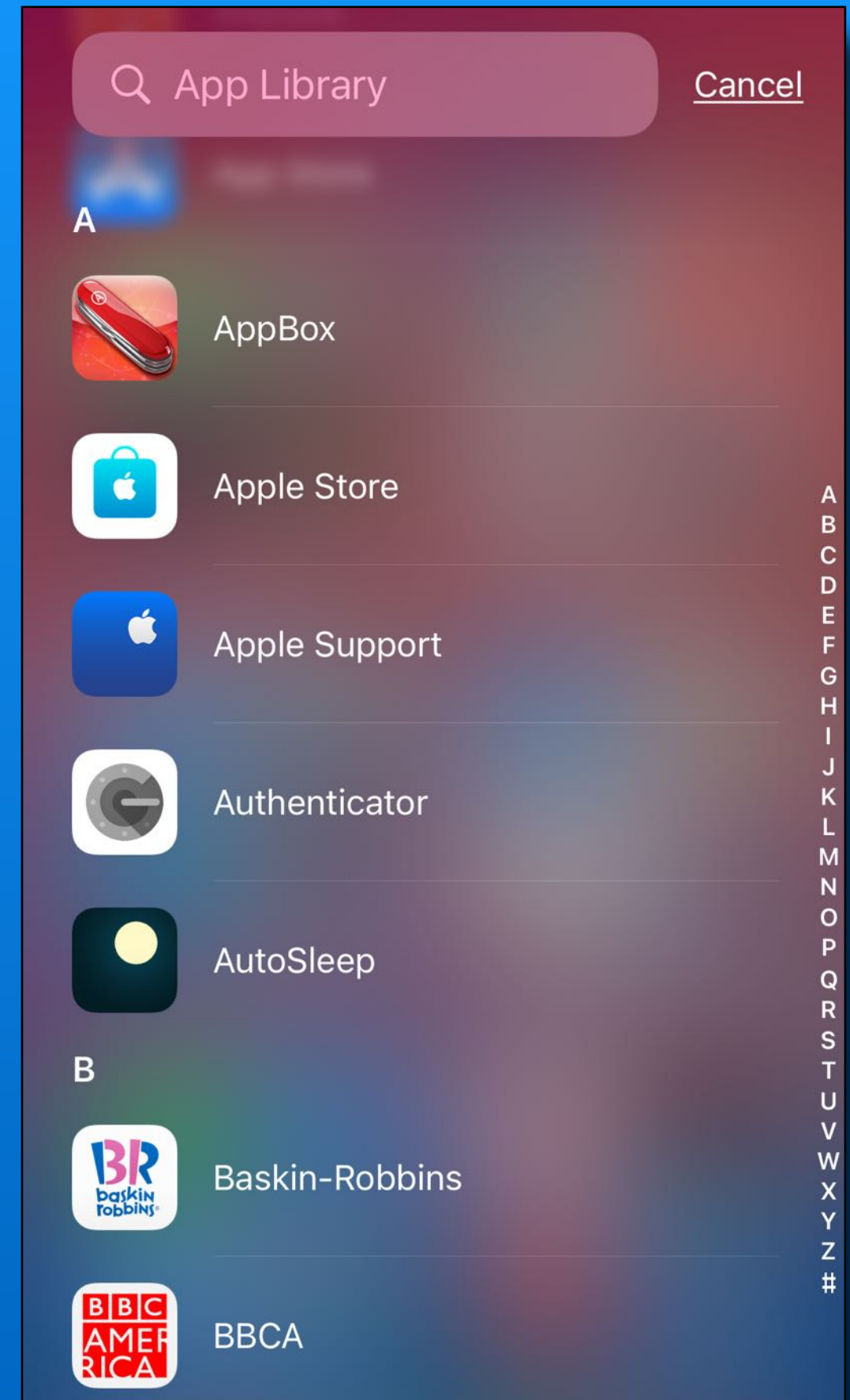

iOS 13.7 Update Exposure Notification Opt-in



- Uses bluetooth
- Detects when two smartphones come within 2 meters for a certain period of time
- Doesn't collect location data
- Uses anonymous digital tokens

How Exposure Notifications Work

- 1 Your iPhone uses Bluetooth to keep a log throughout the day**
Your iPhone looks for iOS and Android phones that have Exposure Notifications turned on and keeps a rolling 14 day log of their shared identifiers.
- 2 People can report that they have COVID-19**
If someone gets a positive diagnosis, they can report it and anonymously notify those who have been near them.

iOS 13.7 Update Exposure Notification Opt-in

- 3 If you've been exposed, your public health authority can notify you**
Your iPhone will check your log for exposure to anyone who has reported a positive COVID-19 diagnosis. If an exposure exceeds your public health authority's guidelines, you will be notified.

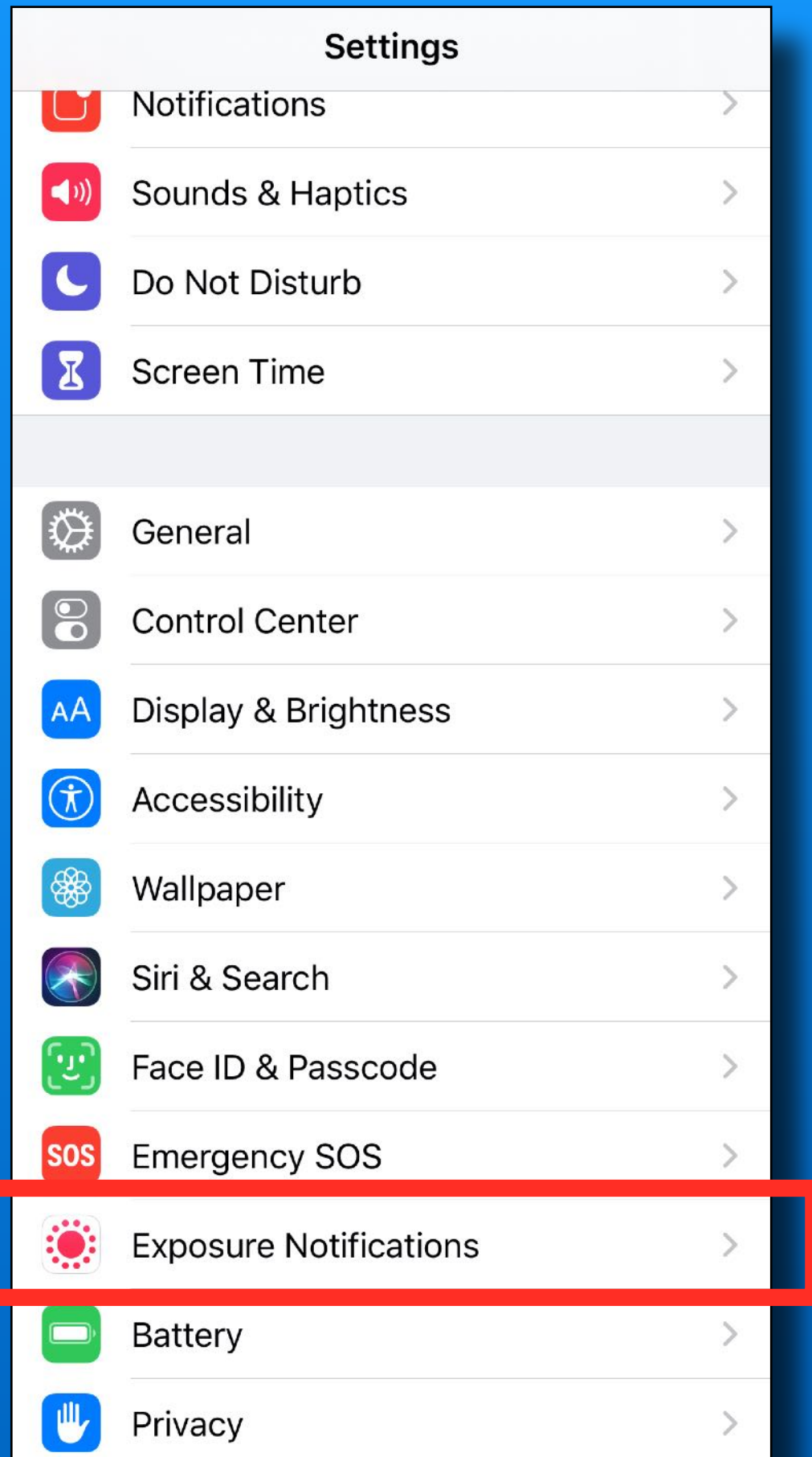
Exposure Notification Opt-in

If you do sign up, and a health agency in your area supports Exposure Notifications Express (or operates its own contact-tracing app), your iPhone collects and shares anonymized identifiers as you come into Bluetooth range of other smartphones. These tokens are generated cryptographically on your device, and they change every 24 hours.

There's no way for anyone to link that identifier to you. The random IDs cannot reveal your name, age, location, favorite food — or any other personal information. Like a lot of Apple's services, COVID-19 contact tracing was designed around strict privacy policies.

- Availability Alerts are on by default
- Leave it on if you want a notification of when Texas begins participation

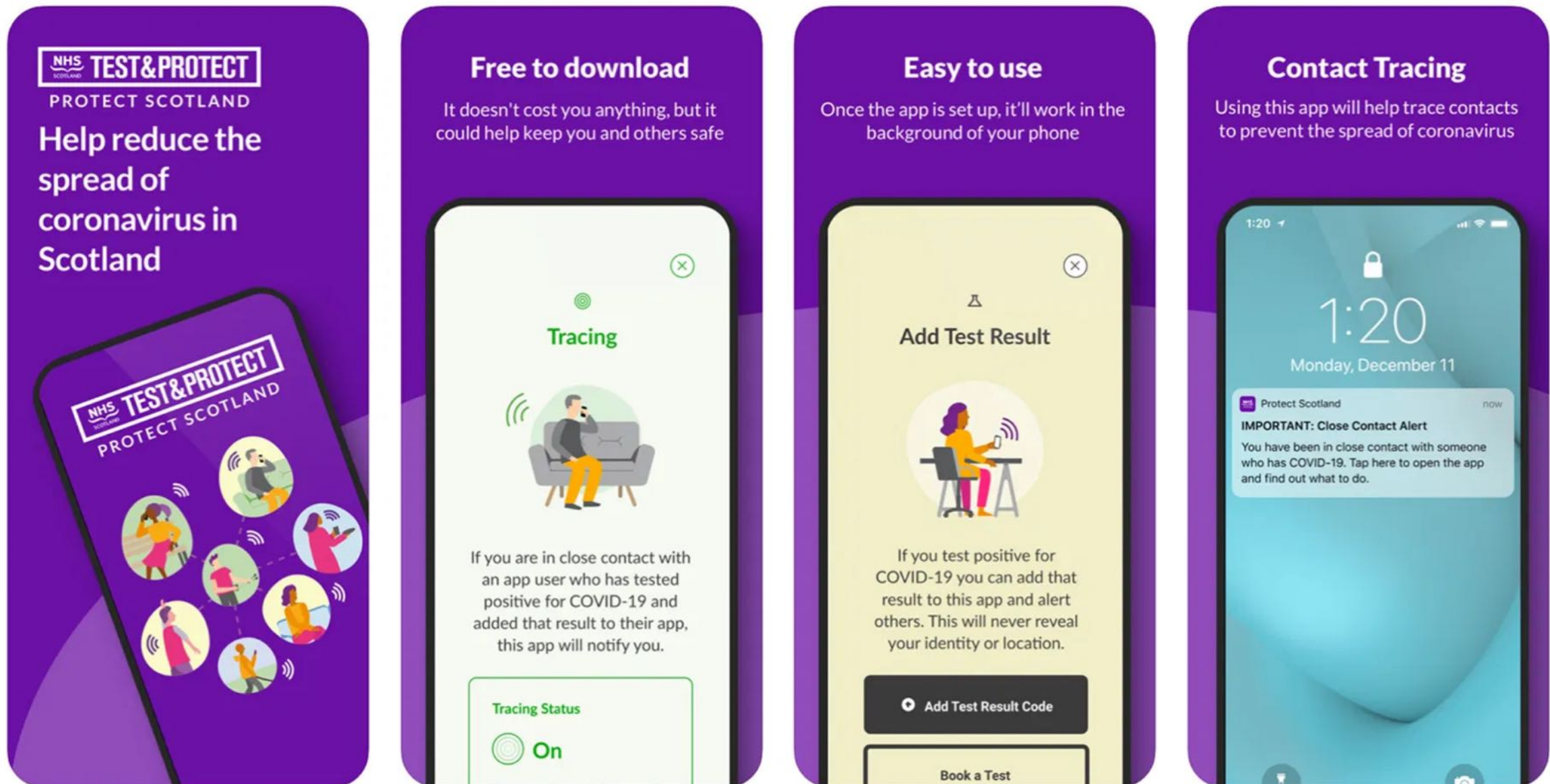
Opt-in Recap

- Off by default
- If on - it exchanges anonymous tokens with other smartphones that are EN enabled
 - When close together - 6 feet
 - For a specific amount of time - minimum of 15 minutes
 - 2 days before onset of symptoms or positive test
- If someone reports that they test positive for covid, public health agencies will initiate contact tracing using Exposure Notification data
- Identity of person with positive test is not shared
