## FRIENDLY NEW YEAR REMINDER

#### WEBSITE REGISTRATION

When you register for an event on the N48 Website, the purpose is to let the contact person know who is coming and what numbers to expect. Numbers are most important when a minimum is needed, or a restaurant must be notified to have sufficient staff to serve a group. Sometimes numbers do not matter, it just depends on the event. Either way, the contact person is doing the work of planning the event and will show up at that event to help coordinate.

The Social Committee understands illness, weather and other unforeseen circumstances might cause you to have to cancel. Please be considerate of your hard-working Social Committee and go to the N48 Website to CANCEL your registration in these instances. If you have to cancel at the very last minute, you can also call or email the contact person so they are not waiting for you to show up.

Recently there was an event where no one showed or cancelled, and the restaurant had prepared for a group. This makes it difficult to coordinate with those restaurants in the future and makes extra work for the Social Committee contact.

Below is a quick reminder of the easiest way to cancel your registrations. If you need more assistance, please contact your Block Captain or Barb Patterson, our webmaster. All of those phone numbers are on the N48 Website.

**TO CANCEL REGISTRATION**: Go to event description on the N48 page and scroll to box underneath it. Scroll to bottom of this box, BELOW your headcount of 1 or 2 etc. You will see a big box labeled "Cancel Registration" – click on this, then on next screen click on "OK" (in response to: do you want to cancel this registration), then you will get a message that says "Registration cancelled successfully". You MAY also click on Modify registration to remove just one of your party, but it is easiest to just cancel the whole party then re-register yourself or whomever is still going. THANK YOU ALL IN ADVANCE for your help!!
