What is the Firewise Wildfire Preparedness Day?

Firewise USA started the Wildfire Preparedness Day in 2014. Sun City held the first day on May 3, 2014 clearing small Ashe junipers around the Social Center and a nearby preserve area. A grant from State Farm Insurance and donations from 3 local landscape companies helped fund the costs.

Wildfire Preparedness Days were held in 2015 -2017 clearing additional areas. However, 2018 was a last minute rainout. 2019 was rain also but an indoor program was presented. In 2020 and 2021 events where not held because of COVID-19 restrictions.

This year the plans are to hold a Wildfire Preparedness Day on May 6 near the Cowan Creek Amenity Center. Planning for the day will begin at the Education/Training Work Group meeting on February 17 at 1:00 pm in the Mesquite Room.
