Malicious Apps to find and remove from your MAC

Malicious apps can and are installed in Apple Macs.

Below is a current list of apps to find and remove:

- PDF Reader for Adobe PDF Files Sunnet Technology Inc
- Word Writer Pro TeamIdentifier
- Screen Recorder TeamIdentifier
- Webcam Expert TeamIdentifier
- Streaming Browser Video player TeamIdentifier
- PDF Editor for Adobe Files TeamIdentifier
- PDF Reader TeamIdentifier

The cited apps have been removed from the Apple store, but they may have been loaded prior to that removal.

Fake reviews added to the ability to alter their behaviour when reviewed by Apple had increased the popularity and download in the Apple store.

Apple Updates today August 17

Press release indicates security and bug fixes for iOS 15.6.1 and iPadOS 15.6.1.

I find macOS 12.5.1 available.

Press release indicates watchOS 8.7.1 to be available but i don't find that update as of this writing. This update for Apple Watch series 3 only.

I checked tvOS and don't see an update.

Strong indications these updates address actively exploited vulnerabilities.

Note: Several browsers have recent updates available this date: 17-Aug-2022.



Apple has released Safari version 15.6.1 for some older macOS versions. Big Sur and Catalina. This Safari update addresses a currently exposited vulnerability in WebKit.

This vulnerability was patched by Apple Tuesday for current versions of macOS, iOS, iPadOS and watchOS.

- Search shortcut Command + Space
- Long press on microphone icon => Siri

Command + Tab
 Menu bar with icons for all open apps

Hit the Command+Tab keys to open the Application switcher in OS X




- Continue to hold down Command key while pressing the Tab key to switch between active applications on the Mac instantly, the app which is highlighted when the keys are released will become the activate application
- Q will quit the highlighted app, H will hide the highlighted app

 Command + Option + Delete

 Brightness and/or Volume by quarter step
- Option + Apple Logo

- Command + Option + P: Try this one after opening Finder. It'll show or hide the path bar in Finder.
- Command + Option + S: Another Finder shortcut. This one reveals or hides the sidebar.
- Command + Option + Escape: Force quit apps.
- Command + Option + W: Close all windows.
- Command + Option + Shift + V: Paste unformatted text.
- Command + Option + N: Open a new window.
- Command + Option + M: Minimize all windows.
- Command + Option + left-click: If you use this shortcut anywhere on your desktop, you'll quickly reveal your desktop by hiding all open windows. You can also try the same shortcut by left-clicking on any open window to hide all but the window you just clicked.
- Command + Option + D: A nifty shortcut to show or hide the Dock.
- Shift + Option + Volume Up/Volume Down: Increase or decrease the volume in smaller increments.
- Shift + Option + Brightness Up/Brightness Down: Increase or decrease screen brightness in smaller increments.


