- Microsoft Data Breach
 Misconfigured server on Internet
 Business transaction data
 Potential customers
 Found by SOCRadar
 2.4TB
- Walmart Checks for Secret Shoppers
- Amazon product review solicitation via postal mail With gift card
 IFF

- Microsoft Account Know your status
- PayPal Financial penalties for violations

 Microsoft Windows warning if password for programs or sites match Windows sign on.

This app made an unsafe connection that was reported to Microsoft for stealing passwords

Your organization recommends changing your work or school password to keep your account safe.

Why am I seeing this?

Change my password

Got it

- 200,000 new phishing sites each month
- 500 different brands
- Increased risk factors:
 US largest target by volume
 Australia twice as likely as US
 55 64 1.64 more likely than 18 24
 Victim of recent data breach?
 5 times more likely

- Microsoft Exchange Server 3(?) 0-days



- ChromeOS 106

- Fake LinkedIn Bots vs. HR
- Akami CDN vulnerability
- Crypto currency
- Crypto exchange bankruptcy

 14,532 pages of customer info
 Name, account & transaction information
- Apple Store & Google Play 400 malicious apps
 Steal Facebook credentials
- Alchimist attack framework
 Windows, macOS, Linux GoLang

- Photo editors, including those that claim to allow you to "turn yourself into a cartoon"
- VPNs claiming to boost browsing speed or grant access to blocked content or websites
- Phone utilities such as flashlight apps that claim to brighten your phone's flashlight
- Mobile games falsely promising high-quality 3D graphics
- Health and lifestyle apps such as horoscopes and fitness trackers
- Business or ad management apps claiming to provide hidden or unauthorized features not found in official apps by tech platforms.



Victims of hackers after world's first contact lens vulnerability is discovered:





 Not recently updated 3 years
 "We update the list, we just don't synch"
- Credit card fraud & 2FA Typical theft from gym lockers Add device to card/account One-time code sent to stolen phone Thief sees code on stolen phone Types code on their phone New device added Note: Wells Fargo and others message has code out notification box

- Tesla and others with key fob
 Stand near owner in grocery store
 Relay (radio) to another near car
 Credit Card "keys" Near Field Communications
- Qatar spyware World Cup Ehteraz & Hayya
- Passkey support Chrome & Android Some sites, Some VPNs Phishing resistant MFA User must Act Phish able




